Monday 2nd March 2009: Departure of participants.

Competition mode: Tournament will be carried out according to the rules and sporting codes of the IJF, the competition system KO with **quarterfinal** (last 8) **repechage**
Seeding of the top 8 among entered competitors according to the World Ranking List. Rest of the draw – separation by nations.

Participation: According to the IJF rules:
Per country : 4 competitors maximum per weight category
Organizing country: 4 competitors maximum per weight category

Judogis: The blue and white judogis will be obligatory.
Judogi control according to Sokuteiki Rule approved by IJF from the 1st January 2009.
All athletes taking part in the World Cups have to carry their **surname on the back of their judogis**.

Doping control: The gold medal winner and another drawn medalist in each weight category have to participate in the doping control.

Referees: Maximum per country: Organizing nation: 6 referees
Participating nation 2 referees
Referees must be holding the IJF license, A or B.

Referees meeting: Friday 27 February 2009 at **19:00** in Hotel DUO, Congress Hall.

Accreditation fee: For participants who wish not to stay in the official hotel DUO 100 € /person.

Payment: Kindly complete the payment before **30th January 2009** to our bank account. All bank fees and money transfer costs must be paid by the sender federation. In case of paying of the accommodation expenses after the deadline or on the spot, 10% charge will be added to the expenses.

Cancellation: Up to 30 days before arrival: free of charge
Between 29 – 15 days before arrival: 50% refund
Less than 15 days: no refund.
