Transfer:	Krakow / Katowice - airport or Bielsko-Biala railway station to hotels in Szczyrk - and back are free of charge for those who pay stay expenses. No transfers from Warsaw.
Competition mode:	Competition will be carried out according to the rules and sporting codes of the IJF – EJU: double repechage competition system; Preliminaries – 3 mats (8 m x 8 m), Bronze medals fights – 2 mats (8 m x 8 m), Finals – 1 mat (8 m x 8 m), Competition time of fights - 4 min, Golden Score-2 min. Application of kansetsu waza is forbidden. Application of shime waza is allowed. The white and blue judogi are obligatory.
Judogi:	All competitors must have and use own judogi white and blue conformity / according with the EJU rules
Participants:	Boys and girls born in 1993-1994.
Accreditation:	Hotel Harnas (COS Szczyrk Plazowa street 8) - accreditation and control of the nation. Friday 22 of May 2009: 10:00 – 18:00 All teams: please make sure that your team arrives prior to 18:00 Friday, May 22 nd 2009 as no additional or any change of entries will be accepted after 18:00.
