Once completed the federation will be issued a link to setup and authorise their personal account which will then be password protected. The account can be accessed 24 hours a day for federations to make additions or amends.</p> <p>The online booking tool will allow the individual federations to amend their accommodation, transport and delegation information easily. All information provided by the federations will be confirmed via email and will be confidential.</p> <p>All federations <b>must</b> complete the online booking tool.</p> <p>All federations will make <b>all payments</b> (excluding entry fees) via the online booking tool.</p> <p><b>The online booking tool does not replace JUMAS. All federations will be required to complete both systems.</b></p> <p>If for any reason a federation has not received the original account authorisation and numerical entry form email, they can contact the BJA Events Team (<a href="mailto:events@britishjudo.org.uk">events@britishjudo.org.uk</a>) for assistance.</p>

Participants accommodated at a non-official hotel will also have to pay £70 accreditation fee to the organisers.</p>						
<b>Entry Information</b>	<p><b>1. First Entry (Numerical)</b>          National Federations are requested to inform the British Judo Association whether or not they will participate by completing the numerical entry form no later than <b>Friday 7<sup>th</sup> August 2009</b>. The form has been circulated via CSE to all national federations. If you have not received the numerical entry form please contact <a href="mailto:events@britishjudo.org.uk">events@britishjudo.org.uk</a></p> <p><b>2. Final Entry</b>          Once the completed numerical entry form has been received by CSE the National Federation will be issued with a username and password for the online booking tool. All National Federations are required to complete the online inscription by <b>Friday 4<sup>th</sup> September 2009</b> so all final team requirements can be confirmed with the official hotel. This <b>must</b> be completed via the online booking tool.</p> <p>All EJU / IJF member federations must pay to the EJU a fee of €10 per participant directly at the point of accreditation/registration. The registration for EJU members will be done by JUMAS ELECTRONIC SYSTEM by <b>Friday 4<sup>th</sup> September 2009</b>.</p> <p><b>Please note: All federations will need to complete both the JUMAS and British Judo's online booking system.</b></p> <p>Competitors not accommodated in the official hotel must pay £70 per person to the BJA.</p>

If you arrive at a London airport there will be additional costs (return journey) for a transfer to the official hotel in Birmingham.</p>

On completion of the VISA application form the BJA will then be contacted to confirm the request. Once confirmed the VISA request will then be processed and the national federation will be contacted via their email address.
<b>Flag and Anthem</b>	Each National Federation must bring one flag and CD with the short version of your national anthem. This is to be given to the organisers at registration on Friday.
