

SWEDISH JUDO OPEN 31 October-1 November 2009

Travel Costs and Visa:	All the travel costs to Sweden and back as well as Visa costs should be taken care of by the participation country/club. The organizer will send an invitation for visa arrangements on request. The visa applications should be left either to the Swedish Embassy or other authorized Schengen area Embassy at least 4-6 weeks before the date of final entry.
Competition Entry Fee:	Entry fee for Swedish Judo Open is 60 Euro per person including lunch during the competition
Special Offer:	No entry fee and free accommodation during the competition for current European-, Asian-, World- and Olympic champions.

Award Money:	There is 1 000 € award money for the Winner of each category. The minimum number of participants per weight category should be 8 competitors. If there is less, the award is 500 €. Minimum 4 competitors.
Training Camp:	From Monday 2/11 to Thursday 5/11 will there be an EJU training camp. All prices include accommodation at Hotel Plaza and full board and camp fee from Monday 2/11 until lunch Thursday 5/11. Single room 425 € per person for the whole camp. Double room 340 € per person for the whole camp. Triple room 280 € per person for the whole camp. Four bed room 230 € per person for the whole camp. Camp only 50 €
EJU Camp Fee:	Through EJU regulation the organizer has to take out an extra camp fee for every participant with 30 €.
Liability:	Neither the organizer of the event, nor Borås Judo Club or the Swedish Judo Federation (not any of its officials or members) will be liable or responsible for any personal injury nor for any loss or damage to your property arising out of your participation and travelling in connection with the Swedish Judo Open 2009.
Insurance:	Every competitor must have an international insurance for injuries.
