**Competition mode:**

Tournament will be carried out according to the rules and codes of IJF/EJU system – KO System with quarter final (last 8) repechage on 3 mats.

**Doping control:**

The Gold Medal Winner and another drawn Medalist from the rest per weight category are obliged to take a doping test.

**Referees:**

Each participating National Federation must be accompanied by one referee having IJF continental „A” or „B” licence but not more than 2 referees. Organisers may enter a maximum of 6 referees.

This is a necessary condition of participating in tournaments, to meet EJU requirements.

Referee meeting on 12th of Feb. 2010 at 19:00 hours in Hotel Arena.

**Special rules:**

According to the IJF the number of competitors is limited as below:

Per countries: 4 competitors max. per weight categories

KO system with quarterfinal (last 8) repechage.

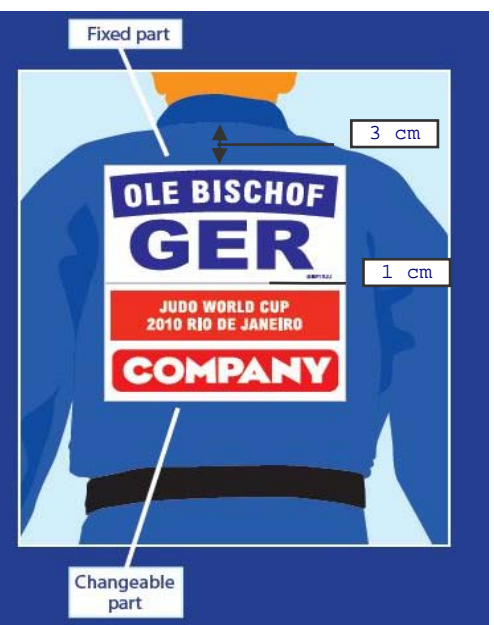
Seeding of the top 8 among the entered competitors according to WRL, rest of draw – separation by nations.

**Liability:**

Neither the organizers of the event nor the Hungarian Judo Association (nor any its officials or members) will be liable or responsible for arising accident or damage during of participation or traveling in connection with this championship.

**Advertisements:**

1. Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his judogi the official back number made up of two parts: the FIXED upper part, consisting of the Surname and the National Olympic Abbreviation; the CHANGEABLE bottom part consisting of the event name and the sponsors, unique for each event.
2. The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the FIXED part of the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from [www.mybacknumber.com](http://www.mybacknumber.com). Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks.
3. The CHANGEABLE part will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number. In case the participating federation sends fewer athletes than registered in the numerical entry, the federation will be charged the cost of the back number of all cancelled athletes.

**First entry:** National Federations are requested to inform Hungarian Judo Association about their intention of participating in Hungária World Cup by sending the entry form (by fax or e-mail) till

**Final entry:** not later than 12th of Jan. 2010 by fax or e-mail.

**Entry fee:**

for participants who do not wish to have accommodation in official hotel **100 EUR/person.**

Money transfers must be completed till **15th of Jan. 2010**

**All bank fees and money transfer costs are to be paid by the sender federation.**

Cancellation : up to 30 days before arrival: free of charge, 29-15 days before arrival : 40% refund, less than 15 days before arrival no refund.

**EJU participation fee:**

EJU rules require a payment of EUR **10** for each individual competitor participating in Hungária World Cup tournament. This amount must be paid by the National Federations for each competitor.
