

EJU INSCRIPTION FEE	EJU Inscription Fee: 10 Euro / athlete
REGISTRATION	All delegates (athletes and officials) requiring accreditation should be registered in Jumas http://europejudo.com/jumas/ by not later than the 31st of May . In the case of delegates without Jumas Membership, the same procedure is being used. Heads of Delegations who need to inscribe any athletes / officials who do not have a valid Jumas membership must have a confirmation from their federation, sign an ID Card Order Form and will be charged € 30 per card (instead of € 20) and the late entry fee, ie € 60.

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SPECIAL RULES	Each delegation may enter up to a maximum of 4 athletes per category (EJU / IJF affiliated federations) both organiser and participant.
VISAS	For nations, who need VISA to enter Portugal, please send us as soon as possible (latest 16 th April) the list of participants with names, passport number, date of birth and function.
FLAG&ANTHEM	Each participating country must bring two (2) flags and a cassette tape/compact disk with the national anthem (short version).
REFEREES.	Every Federation should bring an EJU or IJF Referee. Maximum number of referees inscribed per country: Organising Country: 4 referees Each Federation may enter: 1 referees
ANTIDOPING	The anti-doping control will take place after awarding ceremony. The Gold Medal Winner and another Drawn Medallist from the rest (TWO tests PER WEIGHT CATEGORY contested) will be selected for the anti-doping control.
JUDOJI	The competitions will be held in white and blue judogi. Judogi markings must be in accordance with the EJU regulations. In order to enforce the proper size and measurements of judogi as defined by the Competition Rules and fair conditions for athletes, the special measuring device SOKUTEIKI and a new procedure of judogi control will be used.
BACKNUMBERS AND SHOULDER MARKINGS	<p>The Back Number is divided in 2 sections.</p> <p>The top part of the back number consists of the Surname and Country of the athlete. Should the athlete report to the competition without the official licenced EJU backnumber for Name and Country patch, the athlete will not be allowed to compete. These back numbers can be ordered only from www.mybacknumber.com. It is important to note that production and delivery takes around 4 weeks.</p> <p>It is the duty of the participating federation / athlete to order this part of the back number in time.</p> <p>The bottom part consists of the Sponsor and the Name of the Event. These will be distributed during the accreditation. These are ordered according to the numerical entries. <u>Should the participating federation list more athletes than are actually participating, the federation will pay € 10 per extra athlete (2 back numbers at € 5 each).</u></p> <p>No athletes will be allowed to compete without the EJU / IJF Official Name and Country patch.</p>  <p>As advised during the EJU Ordinary Congress 2010, the EJU decided to allocate the space on the shoulder stripes only to EJU official suppliers, for all official EJU Tournaments (starting from the 15th of February). The</p>



other advertising spaces, as allocated by the IJF, remain as before. Therefore, Judogi with advertising of non-suppliers on shoulder stripes cannot be used. Judoka who like to compete must ensure that the Judogi conforms to these rules and therefore remove the non-EJU Official Supplier advertising or change the jacket. It is not allowed to tape or cover any non-authorized suppliers as this would affect the judogi design and the grip of the opponent.

Acceptable markings

- 1.** National Emblem (on left breast of jacket).
Maximum size 100 cm².


- 2.** Shoulder markings (from collar - across shoulder down sleeve - both sides of jacket). Maximum length 25 cm and maximum width 5 cm in national colours or manufacturer's logo of official supplier. (The same advertising or national colours can be on both sides)


- 3.** Manufacturer's logo (on bottom front of jacket, on bottom front of left leg of the trousers and on end of the belt.) Maximum size 20 cm². EJU official Suppliers are allowed to place the "EJU approved" Logo above their logo (adjacent) on bottom front of jacket. It is permitted to place the manufacturer's logo on one of the sleeves but inside the 25 cm x 5 cm area instead of at the bottom front of the jacket (max 20 cm²)


- 4.** Advertising on the sleeves, 10 cm x 10 cm on each sleeve (different advertising allowed). These areas must be fixed just below and in contact with the shoulder markings of 25 cm x 5 cm.


- 5.** Indication of the placing (1st, 2nd, 3rd) at Olympic Games or World Championships, in an area of 6 cm x 10 cm at the bottom front left side of the jacket.


- 6.** The name of the contestant may be printed or stitched on the belt, lower front of the jacket and upper front of the trousers up to a maximum of 3 cm x 10 cm.



ADVERTISEMENT	During the tournament no back numbers on the judogis are allowed unless specified by the organizer. Back numbers of previous tournaments must be removed from the judogi.
COMPETITION FORMULA	The top 8 athletes, according to the World Ranking List, entered in the World Cup, will be seeded in each category. The rest of the draw will be seeded by Nationality. The System of Competition will be the elimination system with quarter final repechage.
LIABILITY.	The Portuguese Judo Federation (not any of its officials or members) will be liable or responsible neither for any personal injury nor for any loss or damage to your property arising out of your participation and travelling in connection with these championships.
