





If there are not entries from at least 2 countries in any weight category by deadline of JUMAS registration, organizer is obliged to inform immediately the NF concerned.</i>

<p>Competition system</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Competition will be carried out according to the IJF/EJU official rules (Double Repechage system) • Time of fights: 4 minutes; Golden score: 2 minutes • Preliminaries – 3 mats (8m x 8m) • Finals – 1 mat (8m x 8m) <p>Competition systems with low number of participants:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>2 entries:</u> better of 2 fights, if 1-1 the third match will decide • <u>3,4,5 entries:</u> one pool competition system (round robin) • <u>6 and more entries:</u> Double Repechage system
<p>Judogi</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The white and blue judogi are obligatory. • Judogi control according to the Sokuteiki Rule. • All competitors are obliged to have back number on their judogi: <div data-bbox="603 907 1284 1944" style="background-color: #004a99; color: white; padding: 20px; margin: 20px 0;"> <h2 style="text-align: center;">§ judogi</h2> <p>The contestants must wear judogis that meet the following conditions: Made of strong cotton fabric or similar material (see guideline), in good condition (without tears). The material must not be so thick, hard or slippery as to prevent the opponent from getting a grip. Colours: blue for the first contestant and white or off-white for the second contestant.</p> <p>Mandatory markings:</p> <p>Back identification of athletes must include name and country:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have sewn on the back of his Judogi an appropriate back number consisting of two parts: Fixed upper part with surname and National Olympic Abbreviation. Customisable lower part reserved for sponsors and/or EJU event logo, unique for each event. 2. The standardised back numbers and bibs of athletes are described in annex: EJU Back Number 3. The purchasing procedure for the EJU Back Number is described in the annex: Ordering Procedure of EJU Back Numbers 4. Only the original EJU Back Numbers carrying the EJU logo and acquired exclusively according to procedure in Article 3 will be accepted at the judogi check. 5. The EJU Back Numbers are mandatory for all European Championships, World Cups in the territory of EJU, European Cups, and other events specified by EJU. It is valid for all categories (Senior, U23, U20, U17, Veteran).  </div>



Judogi	<div style="background-color: #0056b3; color: white; padding: 5px; text-align: center;">Acceptable markings</div> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. National Emblem (on left breast of jacket). Maximum size 100 cm². 2. Shoulder markings (from collar - across shoulder down sleeve - both sides of jacket). Maximum length 25 cm and maximum width 5 cm in national colours or manufacturer's logo of official supplier. (The same advertising or national colours can be on both sides) 3. Manufacturer's logo (on bottom front of jacket, on bottom front of left leg of the trousers and on end of the belt.) Maximum size 20 cm². EJU official Suppliers are allowed to place the "EJU approved" Logo above their logo (adjacent) on bottom front of jacket. It is permitted to place the manufacturer's logo on one of the sleeves but inside the 25 cm x 5 cm area instead of at the bottom front of the jacket (max 20 cm²) 4. Advertising on the sleeves, 10 cm x 10 cm on each sleeve (different advertising allowed). These areas must be fixed just below and in contact with the shoulder markings of 25 cm x 5 cm. 5. Indication of the placing (1st, 2nd, 3rd) at Olympic Games or World Champion ships, in an area of 6 cm x 10 cm at the bottom front left side of the jacket. 6. The name of the contestant may be printed or stitched on the belt, lower front of the jacket and upper front of the trousers up to a maximum of 3 cm x 10 cm. 
Referees	<i>All participating National Federations are kindly requested to bring International referee to secure neutral refereeing.</i>
Referee meeting	<i>Saturday 06th March 2010 – 09.00 (Sports Hall "Dubrava")</i>
Special Referring Rules for Cadets	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Application of kansetsu waza is prohibited: The referee will stop the action if any of the athletes try to apply kansetsu waza and there will be no penalty. If torus applies kansetsu waza a second time, he is given direct hansoku make and he is not allowed to continue the competition.</i> • <i>Application of shime waza is allowed: An athlete who has lost consciousness due to shime waza is not allowed to continue the competition.</i>
Transfer	<i>The Organising Committee provides the transfer from and to the Zagreb airport and/or the Zagreb train station for all delegations booked in the official hotel.</i>
Liability	<i>Neither the organizers of the event or the Croatian Judo Federation (or any of its officials or members) will be liable or responsible for any personal injury, nor for any loss or damage of property in connection with the trip and participation on this tournament and training camp.</i>
