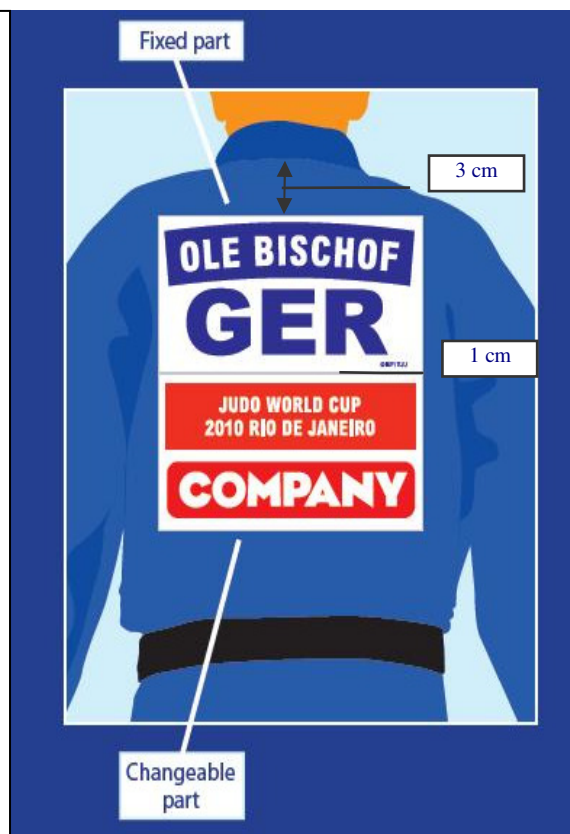

Invited countries:	IJF and EJU member countries
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Competition system:	The events will be organized in accordance with the rules and sporting codes of the IJF / EJU, double repechage system, on 3 mats
Referees:	Each federation may enter 1 referee with at least continental licence. The organizing federation may enter a maximum of 4 referees .
Judogis:	Please note that according to the decision of the DC of the EJU blue and white judogis will be obligatory.
Entry Fee:	According to the EJU requirements, each competitor at the EJU World Cup is obliged to pay the EJU fee of EUR 10 to the EJU. This amount must be paid by the National Federations for each their competitor.
Liability:	Every competitor takes part on his own risk. Each National Federation is responsible for its judokas and must assume all responsibility for accident and health insurance as well as the civil liabilities for their judokas and their officials, including the referees during the event.
Transportation:	From the airport Minsk or railway station Minsk to the Hotel and from the hotel to the Competition hall – by the organizer for all participants accommodated in the official hotels. Please, send Travel Details Form in due time.
Special Rules	According to the IJF the number of athletes is Limited as below: Each EJU / IJF Federation may enter 4 competitors maximum per weight category KO system the with quarterfinal (Last 8) repechage.
Visas	You can arrange entry visas to Belarus either in the country of your residence (if there is a Consular Department of Belarus in your country), or at the international airport "MINSK-2" (code MSQ) upon arrival. Please, send in due time the list of delegation members with <u>their valid passport details (number, dates of issue and expiry), date of birth and intended period of stay (arrival/departure dates)</u> to the tournament organizer. Please, specify where your delegation is planning to obtain visas – in your country, or at the ART. Important information: The cost of Entry Visa to Belarus at Minsk Airport Consular Department for the countries <u>having not</u> the Consular Department of Belarus: Individual – 100 USD. For the countries who have Belarus Embassy- the cost of Entry Visa is 140 USD. (Payment in USD and Euros).
Entries:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>FIRST ENTRY</u> National Federations are kindly requested to inform the TOURNAMENT ORGANIZER whether they will participate in the Tournament by the Entry Form enclosed not later than 1. September 2010. • <u>FINAL ENTRY</u> National Federations are kindly requested to send the Final entry form not later than . 20 September 2010. <p>* All members must register in JUMAS – see details on www.eju.net Deadline: 27th of September 2010</p>

Back Numbers: Numerical Inscriptions must be sent in not later than 2 months before the Tournament. The participating federation should advise how many athletes will be participating.

1. Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his judogi the official back number made up of two parts: the FIXED upper part consisting of the Surname and the National Olympic Abbreviation; the CHANGEABLE bottom part consisting of the event name and the sponsors, unique for each event.
2. The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the FIXED part of the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from www.mybacknumber.com. Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks.
3. The CHANGEABLE part will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number. In case the participating federation sends fewer athletes than registered in the numerical entry, the federation will be charged the cost of the back number of all cancelled athletes.
