In order for an athlete to obtain points for the EJU Ranking List, his / her weight category should have participants from at least 2 different countries. If this is not the case, the competition can still be held, according to the organiser's decision.

If by the nominal deadline, there are less than 2 countries inscribed in any weight category, the organiser is obliged to inform immediately the NF concerned.

#### Destination Leibnitz:

Leibnitz is a small town in the south of Austria, between Graz (capital town from Styria) and Maribor (Slovenia). The airport from Graz (20 km) offers good possibilities to come into the town. With car from Graz to Leibnitz 20 min on Highway "A 9"

#### Conditions

Travel expenses to Graz or Leibnitz will be carried at the federations own expenses. The transfer from/to the Graz Airport/trainstation to the Registration venue and Hotel will be provided by the organiser.

**Transfer will be organized on request from and to the airport or train station in the city of Vienna at the federation's expenses.**

## Judogi

### JUDOGI

The competitions will be held in white and blue judogi. Judogi markings must be in accordance with the EJU regulations. In order to enforce the proper size and measurements of judogi as defined by the Competition Rules and fair conditions for athletes, the special measuring device SOKUTEIKI and a new procedure of judogi control will be used. The women competitors must wear a white non-transparent T-shirt. The bras must not have any hard pieces. Long hair has to be bound with an elastic band. Make-up and jewellery are prohibited. The nails have to be cut short.


### BACK NUMBERS

The top part of the back number consists of the Surname and Country of the athlete. **Should the athlete report to the competition without the International Judo Material Store (IJMS) Name and Country patch, the athlete will not be allowed to compete.**

These back numbers should be ordered from [www.mybacknumber.com](http://www.mybacknumber.com). It is important to note that production and delivery takes around 4 weeks. **It is the duty of the participating federation / athlete to order this part of the back number in time.** The bottom part consists of the Sponsor and the Name of the Event. The organiser will order enough back numbers for all participants according to the numerical entry. Should the participating federation list more athletes than are actually participating, the federation will pay € 10 per extra athlete (2 back numbers at € 5 each).

**If the Judogi of the athlete does not comply with all the specifications of the EJU and the IJF, including the name and country patch, the athlete will be disqualified from the tournament.**





**ACCEPTABLE MARKINGS** As advised during the EJU Ordinary Congress 2010, the EJU decided to allocate the space on the shoulder stripes only to EJU official suppliers, for all official EJU Tournaments (starting from the 15th of February). The other advertising spaces, as allocated by the IJF, remain as before. Therefore, Judogi with advertising of non-suppliers on shoulder stripes cannot be used. Judoka who like to compete must ensure that the Judogi conforms to these rules and therefore remove the non-EJU Official Supplier advertising or change the jacket. It is not allowed to tape or cover any non-authorized suppliers as this would affect the judogi design and the grip of the opponent.

**Acceptable markings**

1. National Emblem (on left breast of jacket). Maximum size 100 cm<sup>2</sup>.
2. Shoulder markings (from collar - across shoulder down sleeve - both sides of jacket). Maximum length 25 cm and maximum width 5 cm in national colours or manufacturer's logo of official supplier. (The same advertising or national colours can be on both sides)
3. Manufacturer's logo (on bottom front of jacket, on bottom front of left leg of the trousers and on end of the belt.) Maximum size 20 cm<sup>2</sup>. EJU official Suppliers are allowed to place the "EJU approved" Logo above their logo (adjacent) on bottom front of jacket. It is permitted to place the manufacturer's logo on one of the sleeves but inside the 25 cm x 5 cm area instead of at the bottom front of the jacket (max 20 cm<sup>2</sup>)
4. Advertising on the sleeves, 10 cm x 10 cm on each sleeve (different advertising allowed). These areas must be fixed just below and in contact with the shoulder markings of 25 cm x 5 cm.
5. Indication of the placing (1st, 2nd, 3rd) at Olympic Games or World Championships, in an area of 6 cm x 10 cm at the bottom front left side of the jacket.
6. The name of the contestant may be printed or stitched on the belt, lower front of the jacket and upper front of the trousers up to a maximum of 3 cm x 10 cm.

The illustrations show: 1. A yellow national emblem on the left breast. 2. A rainbow-colored shoulder stripe and a black 'COMPANY' logo on the sleeve. 3. A 'PROOFED' logo and a 'Factory Label' with '% Material' on the bottom front of the jacket. 4. A 'COMPANY' logo on the sleeve. 5. 'Olympic Champion' text on the bottom front left side of the jacket. 6. 'OLE BISCHOF' text on the belt.
