

Women: -70, -78, +78 kg
After Final block (Bronze medal contests, finals, victory ceremony. Doping control immediately after the ceremony)
- Monday, 14th of June: Departure of Participants
- Competition mode: Tournament will be carried out according to the rules and sporting codes of the IJF, the competition system KO with quarterfinal (last 8) repechage
Seeding of the top 8 among entered competitors according to the World Ranking List. Rest of the draw – separation by nations.
- Participation: All EJU/IJF affiliated federations
4 athletes per weight category from each EJU/IJF affiliated federations including the organizing nation
- Judogis: Blue and white judogis will be obligatory
Judogi control according to Sokuteiki Rule approved by IJF from the January 1st 2009.
All Competitors are obliged to have back numbers on their judogi:

1. Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his judogi the official back number made up of two parts: the FIXED upper part, consisting of the Surname and the National Olympic Abbreviation; the CHANGEABLE bottom part consisting of the event name and the sponsors, unique for each event.
2. The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the FIXED part of the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from www.mybacknumber.com. Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks.
3. The organizer will deliver the CHANGEABLE part during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number.



Acceptable markings

1. National Emblem (on left breast of jacket). Maximum size 100 cm².
2. Shoulder markings (from collar - across shoulder down sleeve - both sides of jacket). Maximum length 25 cm and maximum width 5 cm in national colours or manufacturer's logo of official supplier. (The same advertising or national colours can be on both sides)
3. Manufacturer's logo (on bottom front of jacket, on bottom front of left leg of the trousers and on end of the belt.) Maximum size 20 cm². EJU official Suppliers are allowed to place the "EJU approved" Logo above their logo (adjacent) on bottom front of jacket. It is permitted to place the manufacturer's logo on one of the sleeves but inside the 25 cm x 5 cm area instead of at the bottom front of the jacket (max 20 cm²)
4. Advertising on the sleeves, 10 cm x 10 cm on each sleeve (different advertising allowed). These areas must be fixed just below and in contact with the shoulder markings of 25 cm x 5 cm.
5. Indication of the placing (1st, 2nd, 3rd) at Olympic Games or World Championships, in an area of 6 cm x 10 cm at the bottom front left side of the jacket.
6. The name of the contestant may be printed or stitched on the belt, lower front of the jacket and upper front of the trousers up to a maximum of 3 cm x 10 cm.

- Referees:** Maximum per country: Organizing nation: 4 referees

Referees must be holding the IJF license, A or B
- Referees meeting:** Friday, 11th of June in Hotel Meriton at 19:00
- Entries:** First entry 11th of April 2010. To organizer
