Competition Format: The tournament will be carried out according to the rules and regulations of the IJF/EJU, Knockout & Double Repechage System.

Seeding: Seeding of top 4 among entered competitors in each weight category according to the IJF World Ranking List. The rest of the draw will be separation by nations.

Eligibility: All members of EJU/IJF affiliated National Judo Federations may enter.

Minimum grades: Men: 1st Dan, Women: 1st Kyu.

All British competitors MUST bring their BJA judo licence and all overseas competitors must bring their passport/judo licence to registration and weigh-in.

The wearing of blue / white judogi is compulsory at this event.

Entry numbers will be limited and will be allocated on a first come first served basis. All participants must register on **Friday 14th May**.

Age Limits:

Players must be 15 years of age or older on the day of the event AND a SENIOR licence holder.

Online booking tool:

The 2010 London British Open will be administered via an online booking tool provided by Corporate & Sporting Events (CSE) to gather all individual's entry information, entry fees and accommodation requirements.

All individuals who wish to enter this event must contact CSE on judo@corporate-sporting.com or **+44 (0)121 7790880** to start their application process. Once completed, the individual will be issued a link to setup and authorise their personal account which will then be password protected. The account can be accessed 24 hours a day for individuals to make additions or amends.

The CSE online booking tool will allow the individual to amend their accommodation and entry information easily. All information provided by the individual will be confirmed via email and will be confidential.

All competitors must complete the CSE online booking tool.

All competitors will make ALL payments via the CSE online booking tool.

Please note: Test scales will be available at registration (where the organisers must be notified of any weight category changes). No changes of weight category will be permitted after the draw has been made. Players who do not make their weight category will be automatically eliminated from the competition and entry fees will not be refunded.

Registration for all categories will take place on **Friday 14th May** from 18:00hrs – 21:00hrs in the Goodwood Suite at the Gatwick Hilton Hotel (South Terminal, Gatwick Airport, West Sussex, RH6 0LL).

The draw for both competition days will be made at 22:00hrs on **Friday 14th May** in the Goodwood Suite at the Gatwick Hilton Hotel.

The official weigh-in for the following categories will take place on **Sunday 16th May** from 07:30hrs – 08:30hrs at K2 Leisure Centre, Crawley. Unofficial weigh-in from 07.00hrs – 07.30hrs.

Men: -81, -90, -100kg, +100kg**Women:** -48, -52, -57kg

Referee Meeting: A referee meeting will take place on **Friday 14th May** at 19:00 at the Gatwick Hilton Hotel (South Terminal). Further information will be provided to all referees prior to the event.

Doping Control by UK Anti-Doping (UKAD):

UKAD may conduct drug testing at this event. Therefore any player entering the event may be drug tested, and will need to obtain a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) if taking any medication containing banned substances. For further information see the drug-free sport section of the UKAD website www.ukad.org.uk.

Photography/Filming:

By entering the event, all participants are consenting to photography/filming which maybe taken by the BJA or an official BJA photographer. They also accept that these photographs may be used in future BJA publications or by the EJU.

Transport Details:

It is strongly recommended to fly into **LONDON GATWICK AIRPORT**, as the official hotel and event registration is at the Hilton Hotel, Gatwick Airport (South Terminal).

NO transport is required from Gatwick Airport South Terminal as the Hilton Hotel is within walking distance.

Transport is available from Gatwick Airport North Terminal ONLY to the Hilton Hotel if arranged via the CSE online booking tool. If you require any assistance with your travel arrangements to the Hilton Hotel, CSE will be able to assist you so please contact them via their online booking tool.

Please note that travelling time to the Hotel at Gatwick Airport from Stansted Airport will be approx 2.5 hours, and travelling time to the Hotel at Gatwick Airport from Heathrow Airport will be approx 1 hour (subject to traffic). Please note, travelling time to K2 Leisure Centre, Crawley from Gatwick Airport is approximately 30 minutes.

Payment:

All payments to be made via the CSE online booking tool. NO PAYMENTS are to be made directly to the British Judo Association or the Hotel.

All payments must be made online and be received by **Friday 7th May 2010**.

All rooms will be allocated on a first come first serve basis and will only be guaranteed, processed and confirmed once payment is received. Hotel rooms are non-cancellable and non-refundable under any circumstances.

ROOMS ARE LIMITED SO EARLY BOOKING IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED

Competitors not accommodated in the official hotel must pay £70 per person to the BJA.

THE BACK NUMBER IS DIVIDED IN 2 SECTIONS

The top part of the back number consists of the Surname and Country of the athlete.

Should the athlete report to the competition without the International Judo Material Store (IJMS) Name and Country patch, the athlete will not be allowed to compete. These back number should be ordered from **www.mybacknumber.com**.

It is important to note that production and delivery takes around 4 weeks.

The bottom part consists of the Sponsor and the Name of the Event. If required, a self adhesive bottom part containing event sponsor details will be distributed at registration. All competitors must comply with wearing this if given.

If the Judogi of the athlete does not comply with all the specifications of the EJU and the IJF, including the name and country patch, the athlete will be disqualified from the tournament.



ACCEPTABLE MARKINGS

1. National Emblem (on left breast of jacket). Maximum size 100cm².
2. Shoulder markings (from collar - across shoulder down sleeve - both sides of jacket). Maximum length 25cm and maximum width 5cm in national colours or manufacturer's logo of official supplier. (The same advertising or national colours can be on both sides)
3. Manufacturer's logo (on bottom front of jacket, on bottom front of left leg of the trousers and on end of the belt) Maximum size 20cm². EJU official Suppliers are allowed to place the "EJU approved" Logo above their logo (adjacent) on bottom front of jacket. It is permitted to place the manufacturer's logo on one of the sleeves but inside the 25cm x 5cm area instead of at the bottom front of the jacket (max 20cm²)
4. Advertising on the sleeves, 10cm x 10cm on each sleeve (different advertising allowed). These areas must be fixed just below and in contact with the shoulder markings of 25cm x 5cm.
5. Indication of the placing (1st, 2nd, 3rd) at Olympic Games or World Championships, in an area of 6cm x 10cm at the bottom front left side of the jacket.
6. The name of the contestant may be printed or stitched on the belt, lower front of the jacket and upper front of the trousers up to a maximum of 3cm x 10cm.
