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PARTICIPATION

Players must be born in 1995 or before. Players born after 1995 are not allowed to compete. Participation per country/weight category is not limited. In order for an athlete to obtain points for the EJU Senior Ranking List, his / her weigh category should have participants from at least 2 different countries. If this is not the case, the competition can still be held, according to the organiser's decision. If, by the nominal deadline, there are less than 2 countries inscribed in any weight category, the organizer is obliged to inform immediately the NF concerned. Seeding of top 4 athlete in each weight category according to the EJU Senior Ranking List.

COMPETITION MODE

EJU / IJF system - Quarter Final (Last 8) repechage system. Competitions are conducted in accordance with the rules of the International Judo Federation.

Competition System with low number of participants:

2 entries: better of 2 fights, if 1-1 the third match will decide.

3, 4, 5 entries: one pool competition system (round robin).

6 and more entries: Quarter-final (last 8) repechage

Preliminaries: 2/3 mats (8m x 8m)

Fights for 3rd place: 2 mats (8m x 8m)

Finals: 1 mat (8m x 8m)

REFEREES

All invited National Delegations are kindly requested to bring one A or B referee. All IJF Referees' official hotel/meal costs are covered by the Organizer from Friday 16 July 2010 (dinner) to Monday 19 July 2010 (breakfast)

ACCREDITATION

From 1 to 4 competitor max 4 officials

From 5 to 9 competitor max 6 officials

From 10 to 14 competitor max 7 officials

Entry fee is 10 Euro for each competitor.

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BACKNUMBERS/JUDO GI

Acceptable markings

1. National Emblem (on left breast of jacket).
Maximum size 100 cm².



2. Shoulder markings (from collar - across shoulder down sleeve - both sides of jacket). Maximum length 25 cm and maximum width 5 cm in national colours or manufacturer's logo of official supplier. (The same advertising or national colours can be on both sides)



3. Manufacturer's logo (on bottom front of jacket, on bottom front of left leg of the trousers and on end of the belt.) Maximum size 20 cm². EJU official Suppliers are allowed to place the "EJU approved" Logo above their logo (adjacent) on bottom front of jacket. It is permitted to place the manufacturer's logo on one of the sleeves but inside the 25 cm x 5 cm area instead of at the bottom front of the jacket (max 20 cm²)



4. Advertising on the sleeves, 10 cm x 10 cm on each sleeve (different advertising allowed). These areas must be fixed just below and in contact with the shoulder markings of 25 cm x 5 cm.



5. Indication of the placing (1st, 2nd, 3rd) at Olympic Games or World Championships, in an area of 6 cm x 10 cm at the bottom front left side of the jacket.



6. The name of the contestant may be printed or stitched on the belt, lower front of the jacket and upper front of the trousers up to a maximum of 3 cm x 10 cm.



Blue & White Judogi is obligatory. Judogi control according to Sokuteiki rule. Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his judogi the official back number is made up of two parts: the fixed upper part consisting of the surname and the National Olympic Abb.; the changeable bottom part consisting of the event name and the sponsors, unique for each event. The fixed part of the backnumber must be official EJU/IJF one, which should be ordered from www.mybacknumber.com. Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks. The EJU backnumbers are obligatory for all EJU Official Events: European Championships and European Cups for U17, U20, U23, Se Seniors and Veterans, and World Cups organized in the territory of the EJU. **No athletes will be allowed to compete without the EJU / IJF Official Name and Country patch.**
