

Transportation

The Organizing Committee will provide free transportation as follows:

- transfer from the airport (Amsterdam/Rotterdam) or train station (Rotterdam) to the hotel on Wednesday 13th October and Thursday 14th October
- bus service hotel - training venue / draw on Thursday 14th October
- bus service hotel - competition venue on competition days
- transfer from the hotel to the airport (Amsterdam/Rotterdam) or train station (Rotterdam) on Monday 18th October

Visa

For nations who needs visa to enter The Netherlands, please send us as soon as possible (deadline 29th September) a list of participants. Please follow these guidelines for your application:

- visa application should provide full names, sex, passport number, date of birth, issuing date and expiry date of passport, function
- it is possible to send invitation letters by express mail. The expenses will be charged to the account of the federation and must be paid prior or at the check-in

Judogi

All competitors must have and use their own white and blue judogi according to the IJF rules. All competitors are obliged to have official IJF back numbers with name and country code on their judogi. The local organizing committee will provide tournament back emblems at the check-in. Judoka's are obliged to wear the tournament back emblems and are





responsible for attaching the emblems securely to the judogi. Please ensure that your judogi is dry and clean.

Accreditation

All accreditation cards will be given at the check-in. This accreditation card should be carried at all times. Free accreditations will be given as follows:

Any extra accreditations are available at the cost of €125 per accreditation. Extra accreditations can be asked on the online registration form or at the check-in.

Competition Regulations

The competition regulations have been set up to avoid misunderstanding at check-in and registration or during competition and to avoid possible exclusion of competition. Please read the following lines carefully. By registering for competition your federation declares to follow the regulations and to make sure delegations are aware of the regulations.

- 1) The competitionsystem is the elimination system without repechage with 2 bronze medals for defeated semifinalists.
- 2) **Only** participants of National Judo Federations affiliated to the IJF will be accepted, we cannot accept participants of clubs or individuals.
- 3) Participation is limited to 14 male and 14 female judokas per country, with a maximum of 2 per weight category.
- 4) After the finals there will be an anti-doping control.
- 5) Judokas are obliged to wear **white and blue** judogis.
- 6) Judokas are obliged to **wear emblems of our sponsor on the back of the judogi according the IJF rules.**
- 7) Judoka **without emblem** on the back of the judogi will **not** be permitted on the tatami.
- 8) The times for check in and registration for accreditation are specified in the programme. Competing federations must arrive and check-in within the time limits of the check in and registration for accreditation.
- 9) The Dutch Judo Federation cannot guarantee extra rooms after the 1st of October or at check in.
- 10) Please consider visa applications **on time** and let the organisation know in advance if documents for facilitating visa applications are needed.





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11) All damages to property of hotels or venues resulting from the stay of a national delegation shall be charged to federation and paid in full.
