





<p>Competition System</p>	<p>Competition will be carried out according to the IJF/EJU official rules (Double Repechage System)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Time of fights: 4 minutes; Golden score: 2 minutes • Preliminaries – 3 mats (8m x 8m) • Finals – 1 mat (8m x 8m) <p>Competition systems with low number of participants:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2 entries: better of 2 fights, if 1-1 the third match will decide • 3,4,5 entries: one pool competition system (round robin) • 6 and more entries: Double Repechage system
<p>Judogi</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The white and blue judogi are obligatory. • Judogi control according to the Sokuteiki Rule. • All competitors are obliged to have back number on their judogi <p>Back Number</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his judogi the official back number made up of two parts: the FIXED upper part, consisting of the Surname and the National Olympic Abbreviation; the CHANGEABLE bottom part consisting of the event name and the sponsors, unique for each event. 2. The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the FIXED part of the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from www.mybacknumber.com. Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks. 3. The CHANGEABLE part will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number. In case the participating federation sends fewer athletes than registered in the numerical entry, the federation will be charged the cost of the back number of all cancelled athletes.  <p>The diagram shows the back of a blue judogi with a black belt. As advised during the EJU Ordinary Congress 2010, the EJU decided to allocate the space on the shoulder stripes only to EJU official suppliers, for all official EJU Tournaments (starting from the 15th of February). The other advertising spaces, as allocated by the IJF, remain as before. Therefore, Judogi with advertising of nonsuppliers on shoulder stripes cannot be used. Judoka who like to compete must ensure that the Judogi conforms to these rules and therefore remove the non-EJU Official Supplier advertising or change the jacket. It is not allowed to tape or cover any non-authorized suppliers as this would affect the judogi design and the grip of the opponent.

Acceptable Markings

Acceptable markings

1. National Emblem (on left breast of jacket). Maximum size 100 cm².
2. Shoulder markings (from collar - across shoulder down sleeve - both sides of jacket). Maximum length 25 cm and maximum width 5 cm in national colours or manufacturer's logo of official supplier. (The same advertising or national colours can be on both sides)
3. Manufacturer's logo (on bottom front of jacket, on bottom front of left leg of the trousers and on end of the belt.) Maximum size 20 cm². EJU official Suppliers are allowed to place the "EJU approved" Logo above their logo (adjacent) on bottom front of jacket. It is permitted to place the manufacturer's logo on one of the sleeves but inside the 25 cm x 5 cm area instead of at the bottom front of the jacket (max 20 cm²)
4. Advertising on the sleeves, 10 cm x 10 cm on each sleeve (different advertising allowed). These areas must be fixed just below and in contact with the shoulder markings of 25 cm x 5 cm.
5. Indication of the placing (1st, 2nd, 3rd) at Olympic Games or World Championships, in an area of 6 cm x 10 cm at the bottom front left side of the jacket.
6. The name of the contestant may be printed or stitched on the belt, lower front of the jacket and upper front of the trousers up to a maximum of 3 cm x 10 cm.

Special Referring Rules for Cadets	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Application of kansetsu waza is prohibited: The referee will stop the action if any of the athletes try to apply kansetsu waza and there will be no penalty. If torus applies kansetsu waza a second time, he is given direct hansoku make and he is not allowed to continue the competition. • Application of shime waza is allowed: An athlete who has lost consciousness due to shime waza is not allowed to continue the competition.
