**Duration:** Contest Duration is 5 minutes with Golden Score of 3 minutes.

**Ranking list:** Seeding of 4 top athletes in each weight category according to the EJU Senior Ranking List.

**Referee:** Are nominated by DJB. Delegations from foreign countries are asked to nominate one referee.

The anti-doping control will take place after awarding ceremony.

**Judogi:** Blue & White Judogi is obligatory, Judogi control according to Sokuteiki rule.


**Back numbers:** The Back Number is divided in 2 sections.  
The top part of the back number consists of the Surname and Country of the athlete. Should the athlete report to the competition without the official licenced EJU backnumber for Name and Country patch, the athlete will not be allowed to compete. These back numbers can be ordered only from **www.mybacknumber.com**. It is important to note that production and delivery takes around 4 weeks.  
**It is the duty of the participating federation / athlete to order this part of the back number in time.**

1. Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his judogi the official back number made up of two parts: the FIXED upper part, consisting of the Surname and the National Olympic Abbreviation; the CHANGEABLE bottom part consisting of the event name and the sponsors, unique for each event.

2. The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the FIXED part of the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from [www.mybacknumber.com](http://www.mybacknumber.com). Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks.

3. The CHANGEABLE part (if needed) will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number. In case the participating federation sends fewer athletes than registered in the numerical entry, the federation will be charged the cost of the back number of all cancelled athletes.

4. The athletes must arrive at the competition hall with their back numbers already sewn on the judogi



#### Acceptable markings

1. National Emblem (on left breast of jacket). Maximum size 100 cm<sup>2</sup>.
2. Shoulder markings (from collar - across shoulder down the arm - both sides of jacket). Maximum length 25 cm and maximum width 5 cm only for national colours, and manufacturer's trade mark from official suppliers only. (The same advertising or national colours can be on both sides)
3. Manufacturer's trade mark (on bottom-front of jacket, on bottom front of left leg of the trouser and on end of the belt.) Maximum size 20 cm<sup>2</sup>. EJU official Suppliers are allowed to place the "EJU proved" Logo over their trade mark (in direct contact) on bottom front of jacket. It is permitted to place the manufacturer's trade mark on one of the sleeves but inside the 25 cm x 5 cm area instead of at the bottom front of the jacket. (max 20 cm<sup>2</sup>)
4. Advertising on the sleeves, 10 cm x 10 cm on each sleeve (different advertising allowed). These 100 cm<sup>2</sup> have to be fixed just below and in contact with the Shoulder markings of 25 cm x 5 cm.
5. Indication of the placing (1st, 2nd, 3rd) at the Olympic Games or World Championships, in an area of 6 cm x 10 cm at the bottom front left side of the jacket.
6. The contestant's name may be worn (printed or embroidered) on the belt, lower front of the jacket and upper front of the trousers up to a maximum of 3 cm x 10 cm.



**Entries:****a) First entry**

Federations are requested to inform the German Judo Federation whether they will participate in the tournament/training camp or not by prescribed entry form not later than **June 7<sup>th</sup> 2010**.

**b) Hotel entry**

Reservations only written at latest of July 9<sup>th</sup> 2010, to German Judo Federation.

**c) Final entry**

Federations that want to participate in this tournament are requested to notify the German Judo Federation about all participants, age and weight category by prescribed form no later than **July 23<sup>th</sup> 2010**.

**d) Bank transfer**

Payment has to be made until 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2010

**If payment is made after 23th July 2010 a surcharge of 10% will be levied upon the total payable amount.**

**e) Travel schedule**

The organizer cannot guarantee transfer from Hamburg airport or train station to the Hotel unless precise information with regard to arrival date and place is given until **July 26<sup>th</sup> 2010**.
