Special rules:

According to the new IJF tournament system
the number of competitors is limited as below:



IJF / EJU Member Federations 4 competitors max. per weight category
from organizing country 4 competitor max. per weight category.
KO system with quarterfinal (last 8) repechage.
Seeding of the top 8 among the entered competitors according to WRL, rest of draw – separation by nations.

Dress code:

- Draw: jacket suit and tie
- Elimination rounds: national track suit with trousers reaching down to shoes.
- For the final block program (TV time): jacket suit with tie.
- The following are forbidden at any time: shorter trousers, sleeveless tops, undressed upper body, any kind of head caps and cover, jeans, sweaters or similar sports unrelated dress, flip-flops.

Judogi:

Blue and white Judogi in conformity with the EJU and IJF rules will be required. Only Judogi from IJF suppliers will be allowed.

The space on the shoulder stripes can be only used by the EJU Partners who have bought the right to advertise on the Judogi shoulder stripes (25cm x 5cm). EJU Partners can also be the athletes' sponsors, if these would like to show the company in EJU events.

Advertising on the arms (10cm x 10cm on both right and left side) can be used by federations and their Judoka as usual for their own profit.

BACK NUMBERS

Numerical Inscriptions must be sent in about 2 months before.

The participating federation should advise how many athletes will be participating.

All competitors are obliged to have **back numbers on their judogis** according to new IJF back identification of athletes, valid from 01.01.2011. By decision of EJU DC, the former type of back numbers produced before 15 November 2010 will be accepted for EJU World Cups until 31.12.2011.

Self-adhesive back numbers will be given during the accreditations. They must be stuck on the judogi by the delegations.

Inscription:

All entries, of European and Non-European delegations, have to be registered in Jumas <http://jumas.europejudo.com/> not later than the **1st of February 2011**. The nominal forms are for organisational purposes.

INSCRIPTIONS CAN ONLY BE DONE BY THE NATIONAL FEDERATIONS

EJU fee:

Each competitor at the EJU World Cup Tournament is obliged to pay the EJU Fee. The fee of € 10,00 will be collected at the registration.

Deadlines for the application:

- 1.) First entry return until January 8th to the Austrian Judo Federation
- 2.) Hotel reservations return until January 8th to the Austrian Judo Federation
- 3.) Transfer sheet return until January 15th to the Austrian Judo Federation
- 4.) Final entry by name return until February 1st to the Austrian Judo Federation and to the EJU by Jumas Inscription <http://jumas.europejudo.com/>

Accreditation: All participants and officials should be inscribed in Jumas. The Accreditation will take place at the official hotel according to official program.

Advertisements: Regulation of EJU concerning advertisements on judogi is to be obliged. During the tournament lower part of back numbers on the judogi provided by the organizer are allowed only. Back numbers (sponsor logo) of previous tournaments must be removed and replaced by the Backnumbers of the tournament.

Referees: Participating Federations are obliged to nominate minimum one IJF Continental Referee, classified A or B according to the EJU rules.
The maximum referees that can be inscribed are:
Organising Federation - **4 Referees**
Participating Federations – **1 Referees**
Non-Participating Federations – **1 Referee**

Travel expenses: Participating Federations are responsible to cover their own travel expenses from and to Vienna or Graz. Transfers from Vienna or Graz will be provided by the organizer (**only on Thursday, Friday and Monday!!!**).

Transfer: **The transfer from the Airport Vienna and Graz or from the railway stations of Vienna and Graz to the hotel on Thursday, Friday and Monday will be free of charge for all participants accommodated in the official lodging and also the transfer to the competition hall on Saturday and Sunday.**
