Monday, 13th of June: Departure of Participants

Competition mode: Tournament will be carried out according to the rules and sporting codes of the IJF, the competition system KO with quarterfinal (last 8) repechage.

Draw: Seeding of the top 8 among entered competitors according to the World Ranking List. Rest of the draw – separation by nations.

The draw will take place on Friday 10th June 2011 at 20:00 hrs in hotel Meriton. Each delegation must be represented at the draw, maximum 2 officials.

Dress code: jacket suit with tie.

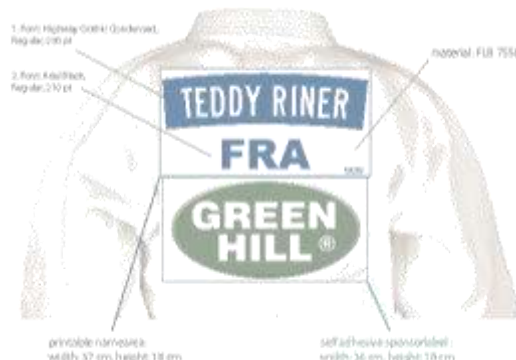
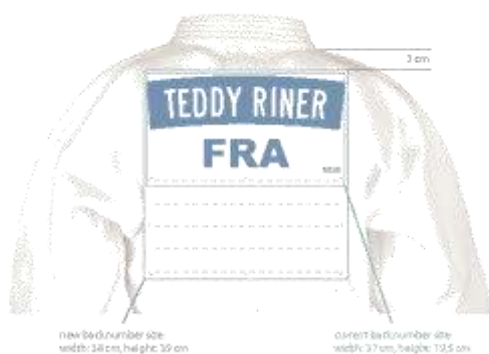

- Weigh-in:** Athletes must present their EJU Accreditation Card and passport (in case of domestic athletes national identity card with photography) at the official weigh-in.
- Participation:** All EJU/IJF affiliated federations
4 athletes per weight category from each EJU/IJF affiliated federations including the organizing nation.
- Judogis:** Blue and white judogis will be obligatory. Judogi control according to Sokuteki rule, EJU backnumbers and Judogi marking rules.
- Backnumbers:** Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his Judogi the official 2011 EJU / IJF back number. The participant athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the back number. Only the EJU / IJF back number ordered from www.mybacknumber.com is allowed. The sponsor part (if needed) will be given during registration & can be stuck by the athlete himself using the special glue.

New back identification of athletes 01.01.2011



- Doping control:** The gold medal winner and another drawn medalist in each weight category have to participate in doping control.
- Coaching:** All coaches must fully adhere to the Code of Conduct for Judo Coaches. Dress Code:
- Draw: jacket suit and tie
- Elimination rounds: national track suit with trousers reaching down to shoes.
- For the final block program (TV time): jacket suit with tie.
- Referees:** Referees must have at least a continental licence and a valid classification A or B.
Maximum per country: Organizing nation: 4 referees
Participating nation: 1 referee
- Referees meeting:** Friday, 10th of June in Hotel Meriton at 19:00.
- Entries:** Preliminary entry 10th of April 2011. To the organizer.
Hotel reservation 10th of May 2011. To the organizer.
(After deadline organizer can not guarantee accomodation in official hotels)
