<p>Competition System</p>	<p>Competition will be carried out according to the IJF/EJU official rules (Double Repechage Competition System)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Time of fights: 4 minutes; Golden score: 2 minutes • Preliminaries – 3 mats (8m x 8m) • Finals – 1 mat (8m x 8m) <p>Competition systems with low number of participants:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2 entries: better of 2 fights, if 1-1 the third match will decide • 3,4,5 entries: one pool competition system (round robin) • 6 and more entries: repechage competition system 						
<p>Judogi Back Number</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The white and blue judogi are obligatory. • Judogi control according to the Sokuteiki Rule. • All Judoka must compete in IJF approved Judogi. • Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his Judogi the official 2011 EJU / IJF back number. The 2010 EJU / IJF back number will only be accepted in European Cups until 31st December 2011. • The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from www.mybacknumber.com. Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks. • The SPONSOR part (if needed) will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number.
