March 26th – 27th 2011, at the Coimbra's **Pavilhão N°3 Coimbra University Stadium**

3. Competitors' Age & Duration

Both men and women competitors must be born between January 1st 1992 and December 31st 1996.

4. Weight Categories

Men: -55Kg, -60Kg, -66Kg, -73Kg, -81Kg, -90Kg, -100Kg, +100Kg
Women: -44Kg, -48Kg, -52Kg, -57Kg, -63Kg, -70Kg, -78Kg, +78Kg

Duration: 4 minutes Golden Score: 2 minutes

5. Inscriptions

The NUMERICAL before January 29th
The NOMINAL before February 26th

In order for an athlete to obtain points for the EJU Ranking List, his / her weight category should have participants from at least 2 different countries. If this is not the case, the competition can still be held, according to the organiser's decision.

If, by the nominal deadline, there are less than 2 countries inscribed in any weight category, the organizer is obliged to inform immediately the NF concerned.

6. Flag

Each participating country must bring one (1) flag

7. Transfers

The Portuguese Judo Federation assures the transportation of the delegation members inscribed by the official entry list from **Official Hotel and Sporthall**

The transfer from **Lisbon International Airport to Coimbra** must be booked together with your inscription and will have an additional cost of **20 euros** per person/per journey.

8. Accreditation

The Accreditation will take place at the Hotel Dona Inês, according to the attached Official Programme.

9. Draw & Competition System

The draw will take place after the accreditation at the Hotel Dona Inês, according to the attached Official Programme. [EJU / IJF Dress Code, that is Jacket Suit with Tie is obligatory.](#)

Competition systems with low number of participants:

- 2 entries: better of 2 fights, if 1-1 the third match will decide
- 3,4,5 entries: one pool competition system (round robin).
- 6 and more entries: DOUBLE REPECHAGE competition system

Seeding of the top 4 competitors in each weight category according to the EJU Junior RL

10. Weigh-in

The weigh-in will take place in the morning on each day of the event, at the OFFICIAL HOTELS, according to the attached Programme.

11. Referee Meeting

The Referee Meeting will be at the Sport hall in the morning of the first day of competition (9 am), according to the Attached Programme.



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12. Back Numbers

Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his Judogi the official 2011 EJU / IJF back number. The 2010 EJU / IJF back number will only be accepted in European Cups until 31st December 2011.

The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from www.mybacknumber.com. Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks.

The SPONSOR part (if needed) will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number. In case the participating federation sends fewer athletes than registered in the numerical entry, the federation will be charged the cost of the back number of all cancelled athletes.

Blue & White Judogi is obligatory. Judogi control according to Sokuteki rule.

All Judoka must compete in IJF Approved Judogi.
