National teams entered exclusively through their National Federations. Participation per foreign country per weight category is limited up to 4 athletes. Judokas representing at least 2 different countries must be competing in a weight category in order to obtain points for the EJU Junior RL. Passports or national ID will be required at the weigh-in.

<b>Competition mode</b>	<p>Competition will be carried out according to the rules and sporting codes of the IJF/EJU: <u>double repechage competition system</u> (6 and more entries);  3,4,5 entries: one pool competition system (round robin).  2 entries: better of 2 fights, if 1-1 third match will decide;</p> <p>In order to obtain points to the EJU Ranking List his / her weight category should have participants from at least 2 different countries. If this is not the case, the competition can still be held, according to the organizer's decision.</p> <p>If, after the nominal deadline, there are less than 2 countries inscribed in any weight category, the organizer is obliged to inform immediately the NF concerned.</p> <p>Preliminaries – 4 mats (8 m x 8 m),  Bronze medals fights – 2 mats (8 m x 8 m),  Finals – 1 mat (8 m x 8 m)</p>
<b>Draw</b> <b>Seeding</b>	<p>Seeding of the top 4 competitors among the entered athletes according to the EJU junior RL. The rest - separation by nations.</p>
<b>Dress code</b>	<p>EJU dress code is obligatory: for draw and medal contests - suit with tie, eliminatory rounds, repechage – national team track suit, or suit with tie.</p> <p>The following are forbidden at any time: shorter trousers, sleeveless tops, undressed upper body, any kind of head caps and cover, jeans, sweaters or similar sports unrelated dress, flip-flops.</p>
<b>Referee</b>	<p>All participating National Federations are kindly requested to bring at least one international referee to secure neutral refereeing: A or B or national level.</p>

<b>Judogi &amp; Backnumbers</b>	<p>All competitors must have and use their own judogi - white and blue. Judogi markings must be in accordance with the EJU regulations, due to enforce the proper size and measurements of them as defined by the Competition Rules and fair conditions for athletes.</p> <p><b>All judokas must compete in the IJF approved judogi. See the Official Suppliers on the <a href="http://www.ijf.org">www.ijf.org</a></b></p> <p><b>Sizes:</b> Each athlete is responsible for his judogi to comply with the IJF Sokuteiki Rule.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his Judogi the official 2011 EJU / IJF back number. The 2010 EJU / IJF back number will only be accepted in European Cups until 31<sup>st</sup> December 2011.</li> <li>The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from <a href="http://www.mybacknumber.com">www.mybacknumber.com</a>.
