



<b>Participants</b>	All EJU / IJF affiliated countries. Both, men and women born 1996 and before. In order for an athlete to obtain points for the EJU Senior Ranking List, his / her weight category should have participants from at least 2 different countries. If this is not the case, the competition can still be held, according to the organiser's decision. If, by the nominal deadline, there are less than 2 countries inscribed in any weight category, the organizer is obliged to inform immediately the NF concerned.

<p><b>Competition system</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Competition will be carried out according to the EJU official rules (Double Repechage system).</li> <li>• Time of fights: 5 minutes; Golden score: 3 minutes</li> <li>• Preliminaries – 3 mats (8m x 8m)</li> <li>• Semifinals – 2 mats (8m x 8m)</li> <li>• Finals – 1 mat (8m x 8m)</li> </ul> <p>Competition systems with low number of participants:  2 entries: better of 2 fights, if 1-1 the third match will decide  3,4,5 entries: one pool competition system (round robin)  6 and more entries: double repechage competition system</p>
<p><b>Judogi and backnumbers</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The white and blue judogi are obligatory.</li> <li>• All Judoka must compete in IJF Approved Judogi.</li> <li>• Judogi control according to the Sokuteiki Rule.</li> <li>• All competitors are obliged to have back number on their judogi:</li> </ul> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his Judogi the official 2011 EJU / IJF back number. The 2010 EJU / IJF back number will only be accepted in European Cups until 31st December 2011.</li> <li>2. The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from <a href="http://www.mybacknumber.com">www.mybacknumber.com</a>. Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks.</li> </ol> <p>The SPONSOR part (if needed) will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number. In case the participating federation sends fewer athletes than registered in the numerical entry, the federation will be charged the cost of the back number of all cancelled athletes</p> <p>New back identification of athletes 01.01.2011</p>  <p>new back number size: width: 38 cm, height: 39 cm  current back number size: width: 37 cm, height: 195 cm  printable name area: width: 37 cm, height: 18 cm  self-adhesive sponsor label: width: 36 cm, height: 18 cm</p>

Teams with special invitation will be provided with inner flights Moscow-Orenburg-Moscow.</p> <p><b>We highly advise you to arrive to Moscow airport Domodedovo (DME).</b></p> <p>Flights to Orenburg from Moscow (Domodedovo (DME) airport):  Day flight departs at 10:40  Evening flight departs at 21:35  Please, book your flights to Moscow accordingly.</p> <p>The organizers will provide you with transfers between Moscow airports. Please take into consideration that the transfer could take up to <b>4-5</b> hours depending on traffic.  The organizers are in charge for transfers in Orenburg airport-hotels-sport complex.</p>
<p><b>Liability</b></p>	<p>Neither the organizers of the event nor Russian Judo Federation (or any of its officials or members) will be liable or responsible for any personal injury, nor for any loss or damage of property in connection with the trip and participation on this tournament and training camp.</p>
<p><b>VISA</b></p>	<p>In case you require visa to enter Russia, we kindly ask you to complete visa application form and send it to the Russian Judo Federation by fax +7 (495) 637 02 57 or by email <a href="mailto:rjf@judo.ru">rjf@judo.ru</a> and <a href="mailto:rusjudo@gmail.com">rusjudo@gmail.com</a> not later than <b>22 April 2011</b>.</p> <p><b>Please be informed that it usually takes 5-7 working days to get approval from our Ministry of Foreign Affairs. Only after the receiving of this approval we can send you the invitation with confirmation. To obtain this approval <u>first page of the passport with photo and personal data is obligatory.</u></b></p>
