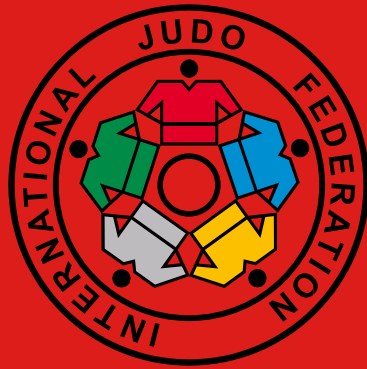

Hotel reservations are made ONLY through the Organizer on a first come first serve basis. Hotel reservations must be made before November 17. 5. INSURANCE

Each National Federation is responsible for its competitors (the control of non-pregnancy as well as the gender control are placed under the responsibility of the National Federations) and must assume all responsibility for accident and health insurance as well as the civil liabilities for their competitors and officials, during the Grand Slam Tokyo 2011.

The organizer of the Grand Slam Tokyo 2011 and the IJF will not be responsible for any insurance related to the above mentioned matters. Nevertheless the National Judo Federation staging the Grand Slam Tokyo 2011 shall take all necessary actions to provide insurance coverage against civil liability for the entire duration.

The organizer of the Grand Slam Tokyo 2011 and the IJF has no liability for any claims of injury, illness or death arising out of the participation and traveling in connection with these events.



6. NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS

Each Country: Maximum 2 competitors per weight category

Organizing Nation: Maximum 4 competitors per weight category

Note:

A. Competitor can only be entered in one weight category

B. Only entries of National Judo Federations – IJF Members will be accept



7. DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION

First Entry (entry by number): **October 25, 2011**

Hotel Reservation: **November 17, 2011**

Visa request: **November 1, 2011**

Hotel payment: **November 25, 2011**

Final Entry (entry by names): The registration must be done with the IJF online registration system at <https://www.judobase.org> until **November 18, 23:59 CET!**

Nations missing the registration deadline will not be allowed to start. No exceptions will be made!

All competitors, coaches and officials must be entered in time. After the deadline no additional persons can be added.

NOTE: It will be allowed to replace already registered coaches or officials; competitors only in the case of an injury.

The flight and hotel information must be entered at IJF online registration system as well!

8. ACCREDITATION CENTRE

The Accreditation Room will be open at Kodokan on **December 7 between 12:00 and 21:00** and on **December 8 from 9:00 and 12:00**. An Accreditation Card with a photograph will be issued to IJF Officials, accredited National or Federation Officials and Media. This Accreditation Card should be carried at all times.



9. CONTROL OF ENTRIES

Control of Nationality and entry of the athletes will be held in Kodokan on **December 7 between 12:00 and 21:00 and on December 8 from 9:00 and 12:00**. Each Head of Delegation must be present, during the control of participants, with proof of their nationality (passport or photocopy of passport).



10. COMPETITION RULES

a. Competition will be conducted in accordance with the latest IJF SOR and IJF Refereeing Rules. Especially refer to the New IJF Tournament System regarding (K.O system without repechage, the semi-finalist losers are bronze medals, the quarter-finalist losers are 5th places).

b. Weight categories:

Men: -60kg, -66kg, -73kg, -81kg, -90kg, -100kg, +100kg

Women: -48kg, -52kg, -57kg, -63kg, -70kg, -78kg, +78kg

c. Duration of contest: MEN & WOMEN: Five (5) minutes (real time).

The "Golden score" shall be three (3) minutes (real time).



11. REFEREES

Referees are appointed by IJF Refereeing Commission.



12. WEIGH-IN

a. The weigh-in will be carried out in accordance with the IJF SOR, Article 16.

b. The Weigh-in will be conducted on the same day as the respective weight category is being contested.

Unofficial weigh-in: 06:00-07:00

Official weigh-in: 07:00-07:30

c. Weigh-in will be held in **Tokyo Dome Hotel**



13. DRAW

a. The draw will be conducted at 14:00 on December 8(Place: Tokyo Dome Hotel)

b. Each National Federation must send a delegate to attend the Draw, a maximum of 2 delegates per National Federation will be authorized.

c. The top 16 among the entered competitors in each weight category will be seeded according to the World Ranking List.

Note: the program is provisional. The schedule is subject to change depending on the number of entries.

Remark: At least one team official must attend the accreditation at December 7 until 21:00 or December 8 before 12:00 in order to confirm the delegation. Without this confirmation in time a nation will not be put into draw and not be allowed to start.



15. JUDO GI

a. **Approved judogi:** Competitors should wear an IJF approved judogi supplied by one of the following manufacturers: Greenhill, SFJAM NORIS, MIZUNO, Double D Adidas, HAYAKAWA, Fighting Film, Budo Sport AG, ESSIMO, MATSURU B.V.

b. **Judogi Control:** It will be operated with a sokuteiki by IJF Education Commission. Judogi must bear an IJF Official optical label which cannot be falsified. One IJF Official Stick on Jacket, one on Trousers and one on Belt.

c. **Backnumber:** Each competitor is obliged to have sewn on the back of his judogi a backnumber

bearing his surname and his National Olympic Committee abbreviation. The backnumber can be ordered from www.mybacknumber.com The delivery can take up to 4 weeks.

d. **Advertising:** Competitors should carry an advertisement of the organizer-dedicated sponsor of the event on the back of their jacket. A fabric bearing the advertisement will be sewn upon their arrival. Advertising on the judogi must be in compliance with the IJF rules.

e. **National Emblem:** Athletes can have their national emblem on the left front part of the jacket within a space of 100cm².

N.B. It is the responsibility of the judoka to comply with the IJF regulation rules.



16. PARTICULAR RULES FOR WOMEN

Female contestants shall wear under the jacket either, a plain white or off-white tee-shirt, with short sleeves, rather strong, long enough to be worn inside the trousers, or a plain white or off-white leotard with short sleeves. All other regulations must be adhered to.



17. COACHING

Code of behavior of coaches as defined in the Sports and Organization Rules, Annex 4 will be strictly observed, inclusive the Dress Code.



18. ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

The anti-doping control will include in each category:

- a. the winner of the category
- b. one of the three other medal winners

As per draw (for b) carried out in accordance with the Anti-doping Rules and the Sport and Organization Rules of the IJF.

The competitors have to report to the Doping Control Station not later than 60 min after signed Notification form, in writing by the Physician mandated by the IJF must follow the indications leading them to the check station. In that period of 60 min. it is allowed for the athletes to take part in the awarding ceremony and to fill their commitments to the press. They are constantly accompanied by persons from the organization from the time they receive their notice until they reach the check station. A person of their choice (team doctor, coach, trainer, delegation head...) may accompany the competitors. The draw is made during the competition before the start of the finals block.



19. AWARDS AND PRIZES (IN TOTAL US\$154,000)

The organizer shall provide for presentation:

Medals, diploma and Prizes:

First place: Gold medal, diploma, and US\$5,000

Second place: Silver medal, diploma and US\$3,000

Two Third places: Bronze medals, diplomas and US\$1,500 for each



20. TRAINING FACILITIES

Planning and scheduling of the training sessions will be organized taking into consideration the request made by National Federation everyday on the basis first request done first served. If you are interested in booking training please send a request for a booking sheet to the Organizer.



21. VISA

The Organizer is happy to help any country with obtaining visa for athletes and officials. For nations, who need VISA to enter Japan, Please fill out the "VISA entry form" attached, and submit it to the organizer via email **NO LATER THAN NOVEMBER 1, 2011**.



22. LAND TRANSPORT

The following transportation is provided by the Organizing Committee.

- Between Narita airport/Haneda airport and the Tokyo Dome Hotel on delegations' arrivals on Dec. 6 and 7, as well as their departures on Dec. 12.
- Between the hotel and the venue from Dec. 9 to 11.



23. FUNDAMENTAL PRINCIPLE

All National Federations, officials, coaches and athletes participating in the Grand Slam Tokyo 2011 have to respect and accept the authority of the IJF officials, the Statutes, the Sports and Organization Rules, the Refereeing Rules of the International Judo Federation, as well as the IJF Antidoping Rules. According to the IJF Rules and SOR Provisions (point 23.8), individuals deemed to have acted against the IJF, its principles or purposes shall be subject to suspension or expulsion from the event and/or cancellation of their accreditation cards.



24. ATTENTION VERY IMPORTANT

The competitors wearing their white judogi (no shoes) will stand behind the podium according to the following order 2,1,3,3. Every competitor having won a medal has to attend the ceremony and receive his medal in person. If a competitor is absent during the awarding ceremony for no valid reasons he will lose the right for the medal. It is strictly forbidden for competitors on the podium to bring national flags or the similar identification other than the one represented in the regular manner on their equipment. Any demonstration of religious, political, personal or commercial sign is prohibited and so is wearing a cap or any other head cover.
