Weigh In	The unofficial and official weigh in will be held according to the times stated in the program. <u>EJU referees who are not nominated for refereeing the competition, or referees with the highest national license, are responsible for the weigh in.</u> The EJU Sports Director will supervise the weigh-in. Each team will present the registration list of minimum 3 and maximum 10 competitors. The weigh in for women will be held in Termessos Hall in Porto Bello Hotel and that for men in the Aspendos Hall in Porto Bello Hotel . There will be 2 scales in each room.
Accreditation	The teams accreditation will be held on Friday 21st October from 16:00hrs – 18:00hrs at the " Pamfilya 2 Hall " in Porto Bello Hotel .
Competition System	<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ One match consists in one round of 5 contests in 5 categories. During each team match, minimum 3 competitors have to represent on the mat, the country the National Federation the club is representing.○ The team will consist of five (5) competitors in the following weight categories: Male: -66 kg, -73 kg, -81 kg, -90 kg and +90 kg / Female: -52kg, -57kg, -63kg, -70 kg and + 70 kg. The competition will proceed in this order. Each competitor is authorized to fight in his category or the category immediately above.○ One team consist in 3-10 competitors and the officials according to the EJU rules:<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ For 7 - 8 competitors five officials will be accredited▪ For 9 - 10 competitors six officials will be accredited○ Competition formula is EJU/IJF system of last 8 repechage.
Refereeing	The referee meeting will be held at the " Aspendos Hall " in Porto Bello Hotel on Friday 21st October at 19:00hrs. <ul style="list-style-type: none">○ The EJU will nominate the referees for each participating country. The referee costs will be covered by the clubs or national federations.○ Each contest of each category has to finish with a decision (if after the regular time is no decision, than Golden Score, then if still no decision hantei). No hikiwake. The winning team will be decided on the number of contests won.○ All competitors accepted for the competition after the official bow on the mat, have to compete. If one competitor does not compete, the club, through its Federation, must pay a fine of 500 EUR.○ A competitor, who has presented himself for the competition and does not compete, loses the right to compete for the whole day. The team can enter another fighter as replacement in the same weight category.



Judogi

- If one team does not arrive for a match after the draw, the other team will be declared the winner by 5-0 (50-0).
- The teams must bring blue and white judogi. The advertising on the judogi should be according to the ECC Judogi Advertising Regulations.
- Official back numbers will be designed by the EJU Event Store. All individual competitors of each team are obliged to wear the official ECC back numbers on their judogi.

Draw

The medalists of the last year will be seeded, than the draw will be done by countries.

The draw will be held at the “**Pamfilya 2 Hall**” in **Porto Bello Hotel** on Friday 21st October at 20:00hrs.

Anti-Doping

Selection of athletes: One weight category is drawn. Every registered competitor of the team takes part to the draw lot. The Gold medal winner and another drawn medalist are tested. In the case of non-contestation of that weight category then the immediate superior weight category or immediate inferior of the same team will be tested.

Transport

A welcome desk in the international arrival terminal will be set up by the organiser for participants arriving at the **Antalya International Airport**. Another welcome desk will be set up at the domestic arrival terminal at the **Antalya International Airport**.

Transport will be organised from both terminals to the **Porto Bello Hotel**.

The Organizing Committee will provide free transportation for delegations between the following:
