Closest Airport and Train Station Transport	<p>Airport: Vienna International Airport or Graz Airport Railway stations: Wien West or Wien Meidling or Graz Hauptbahnhof</p> <p>The organizer will provide transfers between the Vienna or Graz airport or railway station and official hotel and between the official hotel and competition venue. Transportation will be offered only to those participants who are accommodated in the official hotel. Transfers between Airport/Railwaystation Vienna/Graz and the official hotel is free of charge on Friday 10th, Monday 13th and Thursday 16th of February. For transfers on other days an extra fare of € 20,-- per person and per direction is charged. Participating NF are responsible for their own travel to Austria, Vienna or Graz.</p>
Participation	<p>This World Cup is open for all EJU / IJF Member Federations: <u>Maximum 4 competitors</u> per weight category for every federation. The competitors must be of the same nationality as the national federation, which enters them.</p> <p>Each competitors's passport or copy of the passport in case the competitors are still travelling, has to be presented to the EJU official at accreditation.</p>
Age	Minimum 15 years of age (born in 1997 or before)
Competition Mode	<p>The competition will be carried out according to the rules and sporting codes of the IJF and EJU.</p> <p>Competition system: An elimination (KO) system with the quarterfinal (last 8) repechage.</p>
Duration of contests	5 minutes and the Golden Score 3 minutes.
Weigh-in	Athletes must present their EJU accreditation and passport at the official weigh-in. For time and place of the official weigh-in see the Program.
Refereeing	<p>Each federation may enter 1 referee The organizing federation a maximum of 4 referees. Referees must be holding the IJF license A or B and with a valid classification A or B.</p> <p>A referee meeting will be held on Friday 10th of February at 19:00 hrs at TV Hotel. The attendance to the Referee meeting is strictly compulsory. The referees should be dressed formally for this meeting.</p>
Draw	<p>Seeding of the top 8 among the entered competitors according to the IJF World Ranking List. The rest s of the draw – separation by nations.</p> <p>The draw will take place on Friday 10th of February at 20:00 hrs at TV Hotel. Each delegation must be represented at the draw, maximum two officials. <u>Dress code:</u> jacket suit with tie</p>
Jumas	<p>All entries must be registered in JUMAS (EJU online registration system). http://www.europejudo.com/jumas/ Deadline for registration is 6th of February 2012.</p> <p>Delegates not registered in Jumas will be charged 30 € late entry fee. Jumas membership ordered on site will cost € 30 per membership instead of € 20.</p>
Entry Fee	An entry fee of 10 € per athlete must be paid to the EJU during accreditation.
Coaching	<p>All coaches must fully adhere to the Code of Conduct for Judo Coaches.</p> <p>Dress Code: Draw: jacket suit and tie Elimination rounds: national track suit with trousers reaching down to shoes or jacket suit and tie. Final block program (TV time): jacket suit and tie.</p>

<p>Judogi</p>	<p>The competitions will be held in white and blue judogi. Judogi control according to IJF Sokuteiki Rule. Only Judogi from IJF suppliers will be allowed. Judogi markings must be in accordance with the EJU regulations. Detailed information is available from http://www.eju.net/statutes</p>
<p>Back Numbers</p>	<p>All competitors must have the official EJU / IJF Back Number (ordered from www.mybacknumber.com). <p>Responsibility of the Federations</p>	<p><i>The competitors will compete under the full responsibility of their federations.</i></p> <p>Insurance: <i>Each national federation is responsible for insuring its competitors against 'injury and third part risk (public liability)' during the period of the championships. The European Judo Union and Austrian Judo Federation decline all responsibility.</i></p>



	<p>All participants to be accredited must stay at the official hotel. Reservations at the official hotels have to be booked exclusively through the organizer on a first come first serve base.</p> <p>In case of any damage to hotel property or competition venue caused by members of a delegation, their national federation will be charged by the organizing committee.</p> <p>Requested rooms are assigned and confirmed in order of the receipt of the full payment. When your requested hotel is fully booked any reservation will be automatically booked to another hotel of the same category. You will be informed in this case.</p> <p>Cancellations of rooms cannot be made at the Check-In. Visa problems, sickness or injuries are no valid reasons for cancellation of rooms.</p> <p>Delegates accommodated in nonofficial hotels will pay organisational fee 100 EURO per athlete and delegate.</p>																
Payment	<p>Kindly complete the payment for accommodation before 30th of January 2012 to our bank account. All bank fees and money transfer costs must be paid by the sender federation. In case of payment after deadline or on the spot, 10% charge will be added to the expenses. Possible reservations of extra rooms at the Check-In will also be surcharged with 10%.
