Participation	This World Cup is open for all EJU / IJF Member Federations: Maximum 4 competitors per weight category for every federation. Note: • The competitors must be of the same nationality as the national federation, which enters them. • Competitor can only be entered in one weight category		
Accreditation. Control of entries	At least one team official and maximum two must attend the accreditation on February 24 before from 10:00 to 18:00 in order to confirm the delegation. Without this confirmation in time a nation will not be put into draw and not be allowed to start. Each Head of Delegation must be present, during the control of participants, with proof of their nationality (passport or photocopy of passport).		
Age	Minimum 15 years of age (born in 1997 or before)		
Competition Mode	The competition will be carried out according to the rules and sporting codes of the IJF and EJU. Competition system: An elimination (KO) system with the quarterfinal (last 8) repechage.		
Duration of contests	5 minutes and the Golden Score 3 minutes.		
Weigh-in	Athletes must present their EJU accreditation and passport at the official weigh-in. For time and place of the official weigh-in see the Program		
Refereeing	Each federation may enter 1 referee The organizing federation a maximum of 4 referees . Referees must be holding the IJF license A or B and with a valid classification A or B. A referee meeting will be held on Friday 24th February 2012 at 19:00hrs at the Hotel Gromada. The attendance to the Referee meeting is strictly compulsory. The referees should be dressed formally for this meeting.		
Draw	Seeding of the top 8 among the entered competitors according to the IJF World Ranking List. The rest s of the draw – separation by nations. The draw will take place on Friday 24 th February 2012 at 20:00hrs in Hotel Gromada Each delegation must be represented at the draw, maximum two officials. <u>Dress code:</u> jacket suit with tie.		
Jumas	All entries must be registered in JUMAS (EJU online registration system). http://www.europejudo.com/jumas/ Deadline for registration is Monday 20th February 2012. Delegates not registered in Jumas will be charged 30 € late entry fee. Jumas membership ordered on site will cost € 30 per membership instead of € 2		
Entry Fee	An entry fee of 10 € per athlete must be paid to the EJU during accreditation.		
Coaching	All coaches must fully adhere to the Code of Conduct for Judo Coaches. Dress Code: - Draw: jacket suit and tie - Elimination rounds: national track suit with trousers reaching down to shoes or Jacket suit with Tie. For the final block program (TV time): jacket suit with tie.		
Judogi	The competitions will be held in white and blue judogi. Judogi control according to IJF Sokuteiki Rule. Only Judogi from IJF suppliers will be allowed. Judogi markings must be in accordance with the EJU regulations. Detailed information is available from http://www.eju.net/statutes
