- Draw:** Seeding of the top 4 competitors in each weight category according to the EJU Junior RL.
In case there are 2 athletes from the same country in the top 4, the athletes will be separated by nation.
The draw will take place on Friday at **20:00 hrs in Sportforum**
Each delegation must be represented at the draw, maximum two officials.

Dress Code: jacket suit with tie!

Competition system:

Double repechage system on five mats
Competition systems with low number of participants:

- 2 entries: better of 2 fights, if 1-1 the third match will decide
- 3,4,5 entries: round robin competition system
- 6 and more entries: repechage competition system

Updated round robin rules 2012 can be found in the EJU General Handbook on the EJU Website, downloads section.

Duration: Contest Duration is 4 minutes with Golden Score of 2 minutes.

Weigh-in: Athletes must present their EJU accreditation card and **passport**

Ranking list: Seeding of the 4 top competitors in each weight category according to the EJU Junior Ranking List.

Participation: Men and Women born in 1993 - 1997 of all EJU/IJF affiliated federations. Passports will be required at the weigh-in. Competitors will only represent the Country recognised by their passport. In case a Federation or a club registers an athlete with a different Nationality, a confirmation letter from the Federation of the same Athlete's Nationality should be presented during the accreditation.

Referees: are nominated by the German Judo Federation. Each delegation should bring an IJF/Continental license referee.

Coaching: All coaches must fully adhere to the Code of Conduct for Judo Coaches. Forbidden is coaching throughout the contest except for between Matte and Hajime (the coach is only allowed to speak to his athlete between Matte and Hajime)

- Draw: jacket suit and tie
- Elimination rounds: national track suit with trousers reaching down to shoes or jacket suit and tie
- For the final block program (TV time): jacket suit with tie

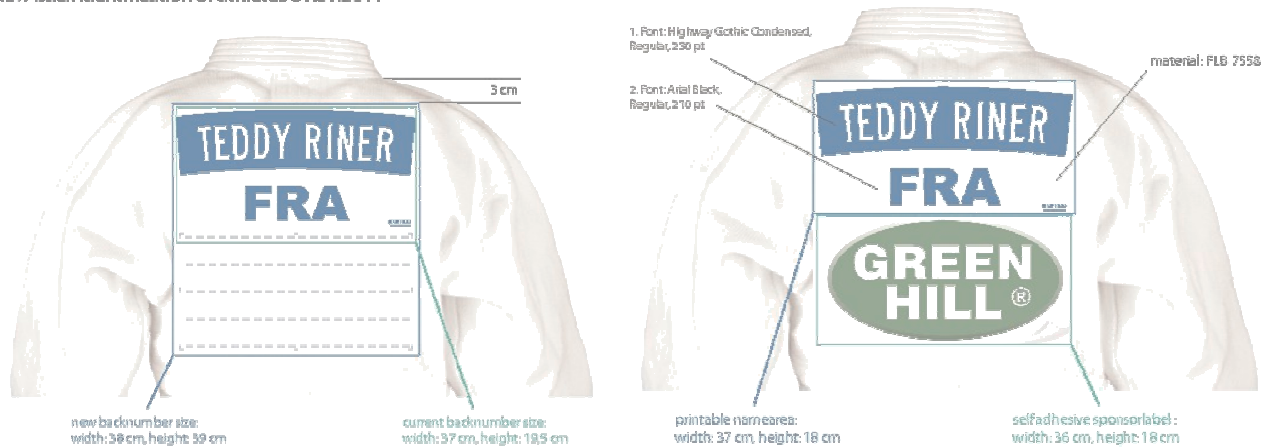
Judogi: White and blue judogi is obligatory. Judogi control according to Sokuteiki rule. All judoka must compete in IJF-approved judogi. Detailed information about judogi is available on the EJU website

- **Back Numbers:** Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his Judogi the official 2011 EJU / IJF back number.
- The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from www.mybacknumber.com.

Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks. Athletes without the appropriate back number will be out of the competition, No reserve Judo Gi will be available.

- The SPONSOR part (if needed) will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number. In case the participating federation sends fewer athletes than registered in the numerical entry, the federation will be charged the cost of the back number of all cancelled athletes.

Announcement of participation:

Federations are requested to inform the German Judo Federation until 15th June 2012 whether they will participate in the tournament.

Entries:

Jumas inscription is obligatory. Participants must be registered in Jumas, otherwise they will face a late entry fee of € 30 each. Deadline for registration is Monday, 6th August 2012. Participants without valid EJU Jumas membership have to pay a € 30 penalty; Jumas membership must then be ordered through their federation. Jumas website: <https://jumas12.net/user/login>

Travel schedule:
