





Participants	All EJU / IJF affiliated countries Age Category: 15 years (in the calendar year) and over (born 1997 and before) In order for an athlete to obtain points for the EJU Ranking List, his / her weight category should have participants from at least 2 different countries. If this is not the case, the competition can still be held, according to the organiser’s decision. If, by the nominal deadline, there are less than 2 countries inscribed in any weight category, the organizer is obliged to inform immediately the NF concerned. IMPORTANT Numerical inscriptions Numerical Inscriptions must be sent in about 2 months before. The participating federation should advise how many athletes will be participating. Nominal inscriptions The nominal inscriptions must be entered into JUMAS. The nominal inscriptions and travel plan must be sent to organizing committee, by e-mail till May,2 2012. Closing date for entries - May,2 2012. All entries must be registered in JUMAS (EJU online registration system). https://jumas12.net/user/login Deadline for registration is Monday - 14 May 2012. According to EJU rules: Delegates not registered in Jumas will be charged 30 € late entry fee. Jumas membership ordered on site will cost € 30 per card.

<p>Competition system</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Competition will be carried out according to the EJU official rules (Double Repechage system). • Time of fights: 5 minutes; Golden score: 3 minutes • Preliminaries – 3 mats (8m x 8m) • Semifinals – 2 mats (8m x 8m) • Finals – 1 mat (8m x 8m) • • Competition system with less than 5 competitors will be played in Round Robin. (Further information will be found in the EJU Handbook and the EJU Website)
<p>Judogi and backnumbers</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The white and blue judogi are obligatory. • All Judoka must compete in IJF Approved Judogi. • Judogi control according to the Sokuteiki Rule. The detailed information about the Judogi is available on the EJU website. • All competitors are obliged to have back number on their judogi: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his Judogi the official 2011 EJU / IJF back number. 2. The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from www.mybacknumber.com. Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks. 3. Athletes without the appropriate back number will be out of the competition, No reserve judogi will be available. <p>The SPONSOR part (if needed) will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number. In case the participating federation sends fewer athletes than registered in the numerical entry, the federation will be charged the cost of the back number of all cancelled athletes.</p>

We highly advise you to arrive to Moscow airport Domodedovo (DME). Flights to Orenburg from Moscow (Domodedovo (DME) airport): Day flight departs at 10:40 Evening flight departs at 21:35 Please, book your flights to Moscow accordingly. The organizers will provide you with transfers between Moscow airports. Please take into consideration that the transfer could take up to 4-5 hours depending on traffic. The organizers are in charge for transfers in Orenburg airport-hotels-sport complex.</p>

VISA	<p>In case you require visa to enter Russia, we kindly ask you to complete visa application form and send it to the Russian Judo Federation by fax +7 (495) 637 02 57 or by email rjf@judo.ru and rusjudo@gmail.com not later than <u>19 April 2012.</u> Please be informed that it usually takes 5-7 working days to get approval from our Ministry of Foreign Affairs. Only after the receiving of this approval we can send you the invitation with confirmation. To obtain this approval <u>first page of the passport with photo and personal data is obligatory.</u> <u>Schengen States – no passport copies needed, just filled in visa form.</u></p>
