<b>Monday – Wednesday, May 21<sup>th</sup> - 23<sup>rd</sup></b>	Departure of the Delegations / Beginning of the <b>EJU Training Camp</b> for cadets which will be held in Bielsko Biala from May 21 to May 23 / no registration fee! <b>Entries</b> should be made together with <b>competitions entries</b> . Accommodation and meals are to be borne by the participating federations! See the information below.		
<b>Participation</b>	Age Category: age 15 & 16 ( <b>born 1996 – 1997</b> ) <b>All EJU / IJF affiliated countries</b> In order for an athlete to obtain points for the EJU Ranking List, his / her weight category should have participants from at least 2 different countries. If this is not the case, the competition can still be held, according to the organiser's decision. <b>If</b> , by the nominal deadline, there is only one country inscribed in any weight category, the organizer is obliged to inform immediately the NF concerned.

<b>Competition System</b>	<p>Double repechage competition system.</p> <p>Competition systems with less than 5 Competitors will be played in Round Robin. (Further information will be found on the EJU Handbook on the EJU Website)</p>
<b>Draw</b>	<p>Draw for all weight categories will be held on <b>Friday 18<sup>th</sup> May 2012</b> at <b>21:00</b> - Hotel Magura</p> <p>No Seeding. (Only separation by nations)</p> <p>Each delegation must be represented at the draw. Competition sheets will be distributed right after the draw.</p> <p>EJU / IJF Dress Code: jacket suit with tie.</p>
<b>Weigh-in</b>	<p>Athletes must present their EJU accreditation and passport or identity card with photo at the official weigh-in.</p> <p>Athletes are not allowed to weigh-in naked. Boys must wear at least underwear and girls at least underwear and a T-shirt. <b>Additional 100g</b> will be allowed for their weight category limits. For time and place of the official weigh-in see the Program.</p>
<b>Refereeing</b>	<p><b>The Refereeing will be according to the EJU/IJF refereeing rules.</b></p> <p><b>Special Refereeing Rules for Cadets:</b></p> <p>Application of kansetsu waza is prohibited: The referee will stop the action if any of the athletes try to apply kansetsu waza and there will be no penalty. If tori applies kansetsu waza a second time, he is given direct hansoku make and he is not allowed to continue the competition.</p> <p>Application of shime waza is allowed: An athlete who has lost consciousness due to shime waza is not allowed to continue the competition</p>
<b>Referee</b>	<p>Each delegation should bring an IJF/ Continental licensed referee.</p> <p>A referee meeting will be held on Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> May 2012 at 9:00h at the Sport Hall</p>
<b>Jumas</b>	<p>All entries must be registered in JUMAS (EJU online registration system).  <a href="https://jumas12.net/user/login">https://jumas12.net/user/login</a></p> <p>Deadline for registration is <b>Monday 14<sup>th</sup> May 2012</b>.</p> <p>Delegates not registered in Jumas will be charged 30 € late entry fee.</p> <p>Jumas membership ordered on site will cost € 30 per membership.</p>
<b>Coaching</b>	<p>The coach is responsible for his athlete's conduct from entering the competition venue until leaving it, before and after each contest.</p> <p>Coaching will be strictly limited to communication with athlete, tactical advice, encouragement, instructions in unexpected situations, as injury, etc.</p> <p>The coach will remain seated on his chair throughout the contest and will leave the mat together with his athlete.</p> <p>The coach should make sure that the competitor leaves the mat immediately; otherwise the whole team will be suspended.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Draw meetings: jacket suit with tie</li> <li>• Elimination rounds: national track suit with trousers reaching down to shoes.</li> <li>• For the final block program (TV time): jacket suit with tie.</li> </ul> <p>The following are forbidden at any time: shorter trousers, undressed upper body, sleeveless T-shirts, any kind of head caps and cover, jeans, sweaters or similar sports unrelated dress, flip-flops.</p>



<p><b>Judogi</b></p>	<p><b>Blue &amp; White Judogi is obligatory.</b> Judogi control according to Sokuteki rule.  <b>All Judoka must compete in IJF Approved Judogi.</b> The detailed information about the Judogi is available on the EJU website.</p>
<p><b>Back Numbers</b></p>	<p>Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his Judogi the official 2011 EJU / IJF back number. The 2011 Back Number version is obligatory.</p> <p>The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from <a href="http://www.mybacknumber.com">www.mybacknumber.com</a>. Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks. Athletes without the appropriate back number will be out of the competition, No reserve Judo Gi will be available.</p> <p>The SPONSOR part (if needed) will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number.
