


	<p><b><u>by Monday 7th May 2012.</u></b> <b><u>All teams or individual competitors MUST also complete the CSE online booking tool (<a href="mailto:judo@corporate-sporting.com">judo@corporate-sporting.com</a>) by Monday 30th April 2012.</u></b></p> <p>According to EJU rules JUMAS inscription is obligatory. Participants must be registered for the event in JUMAS, otherwise they will face a late entry fee of €30 per participant at registration payable to the EJU.</p> <p>EJU JUMAS membership ordered on site will cost €30 per card which is payable to the EJU.</p> <p><b>All teams and individuals will need to complete both the EJU JUMAS and CSE online booking system.</b></p> <p>If you have any questions on the above please contact the BJA Events Team (<a href="mailto:events@britishjudo.org.uk">events@britishjudo.org.uk</a>) for assistance.</p>

<p><b>Entry information and Accommodation booking - CSE Online Booking Tool</b></p>	<p>The 2012 London British Open entry information and accommodation booking will be administered via the online booking tool provided by Corporate &amp; Sporting Events (CSE) to gather all teams and individual's entry information and accommodation requirements.</p> <p><b>Please note: Entry must be made via the EJU JUMAS System also.</b></p> <p>All teams or individuals who wish to book accommodation and inform CSE of entry information for this event must contact CSE on <a href="mailto:judo@corporate-sporting.com"><b><u>judo@corporate-sporting.com</u></b></a> or <b>+44 (0)1217790880</b> to start their application process. Once completed, the individual will be issued a link to set up and authorise their personal account which will then be password protected. <b>Weight Categories and Contest Duration</b>	<p><b>Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> May 2012:</b> Men: -60kg, -66kg, -73kg                      Women: -63, -70, -78, +78kg</p> <p><b>Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> May 2012:</b> Men: -81kg, -90kg, -100kg, +100kg      Women: -48, -52, -57kg</p> <p>Please note: Test scales will be available at registration (where the organisers must be notified of any weight category changes). No changes of weight category will be permitted after the draw has been made. Players who do not make their weight category will be automatically eliminated from the competition and entry fees will not be refunded.</p> <p><b>Duration of Contest:</b> 5 minutes <b>Duration of Golden Score:</b> 3 minutes</p>
<b>Participation</b>	<p><b>Eligibility:</b> Only members of EJU/IJF affiliated National Judo Federations may enter.</p> <p><b>Age Limits:</b> Players must be born in 1997 (15 years and over - in the calendar year) or before AND must be a SENIOR licence holder.</p> <p><b>Minimum grades:</b> Men: 1st Dan, Women: 1st Kyu.</p> <p><b>EJU Ranking Points:</b> In order for an athlete to obtain points for the EJU Ranking List, his / her weight category must have participants from at least 2 different countries. If this is not the case, the competition can still be held, according to the organiser's decision.</p>
<b>Accreditation, Registration &amp; Draw</b>	<p>Registration for all categories will take place on <b>Friday 11th May 2012</b> from 10:00hrs – 18:00hrs in the Goodwood Suite at the Gatwick Hilton Hotel (South Terminal, Gatwick Airport, West Sussex, RH6 0LL).</p> <p>The draw for both competition days will be made at 20:00hrs on <b>Friday 11th May 2012</b> in the Goodwood Suite at the Gatwick Hilton Hotel. <b>Competition System</b>	<p>Double repechage competition system will be used.</p> <p>Competition system with less than 5 competitors will be played in Round Robin (further information on the EJU Handbook on the EJU website)</p> <p>The tournament will be carried out according to the rules and regulations of the IJF/EJU.</p>
<b>Referees</b>	<p>All delegations must bring an IJF/ Continental licensed referee. This is recommended by the EJU.</p> <p>Each federation can enter a maximum of two referee's.</p> <p>The referees meeting will take place at the K2, Crawley at 09:00hrs on <b>Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> May 2012.</b></p>
<b>Coach Dress Code</b>	<p><b>Draw:</b> Suit jacket, trousers and tie</p> <p><b>Elimination rounds:</b> National track suit with trousers reaching down to shoes.</p> <p><b>For the final block program (TV time):</b> Suit jacket with tie.</p> <p><b>The following are forbidden at any time:</b> Shorter trousers, sleeveless tops, undressed upper body, any kind of head caps and cover, jeans, sweaters or similar sports unrelated dress, flip-flops.</p>
<b>Judogi</b>	<p>Blue and white Judogi's will be required. Judogo control is according to the Sokuteki rule.</p> <p>All judoka <b>MUST</b> compete in an IJF Approved Judogi. The detailed information about the Judogi is available on the EJU website (<a href="http://www.eju.net/statutes">http://www.eju.net/statutes</a>)</p>

<b>Liability</b>	The British Judo Association (or any of its officials or members) will not be liable or responsible for any personal injury or for any loss or damage to your property arising out of your participation and travelling in connection with this event.
<b>Back Numbers</b>	<p>All competitors must have the official 2011 EJU / IJF Back Number (ordered from <a href="http://www.mybacknumber.com">www.mybacknumber.com</a>). The 2011 Back Number is obligatory.</p> <p>The participating athlete / Federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from <a href="http://www.mybacknumber.com">www.mybacknumber.com</a>. Production and delivery takes around four weeks. Athletes without the appropriate back number will be withdrawn from the competition, No Reserve Judo Gi will be available.</p> <p>The SPONSOR part (if needed) will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number. In case the participating federation sends fewer athletes than registered in the numerical entry, the federation will be charged the cost of the back number of all cancelled athletes.</p> <p><b>If the Judogi of the athlete does not comply with all the specifications of the EJU and the IJF, including the Back Number, the athlete will be disqualified from the tournament.</b></p> <p>New back identification of athletes 01.01.2011</p>
