

AGE - PARTICIPATION

Age Category: age 15 - 19 (born 1993 – 1997)

All EJU / IJF affiliated countries

In order for an athlete to obtain points for the EJU Ranking List, his / her weight category should have participants from at least 2 different countries. If this is not the case, the competition can still be held, according to the organiser's decision.

If, by the nominal deadline, there is only one country inscribed in any weight category, the organizer is obliged to inform immediately the NF concerned.

According to EJU rules: Jumas inscription is obligatory. Participants must be registered in Jumas, otherwise they will face a late entry fee of € 30 per participant. The deadline is Monday of the week of the Tournament, 7th May 2012. Participants without a valid EJU Jumas membership have to pay a € 30 penalty per participant. After this time, the delegations will not be registered for the draw.

From the Maison du Judo, each delegation will be taken to its hotel.
Each delegation will have to confirm the day and time of departure.

CONDITIONS OF INVITATION

Travel expenses are the charge of the delegations.

Stay expenses of the countries with a special invitation are the charge of the FFJDA (accommodation and meals for the number of persons indicated in the letter of invitation). Any extra person/day will be the financial charge of the federation concerned: **(300 Euros per person full board, twin room, from Friday evening to Monday morning).**

Period of invitation :

- For the nations from the Asian, Oceania and Pan-American continents from Wednesday 09th May until Monday 14th May 2012 in the morning.
- For the other countries (European and Africa nations), from Friday 11th May (arrival to Lyon before 17.00) until Monday 14th May 2012 in the morning.

FEES

Other nations will bear **the totality of their accommodation and meals expenses for their delegation** (300 Euros per person full board from Friday evening to Monday morning).

Tournament :

Free for the invited nations (within the limits of the guest nations). Any extra person will pay 300 Euros per person full board, twin room, from Friday evening to Monday morning.

Other nations: **300 Euros per person** full board from Friday evening to Monday morning.

Training Camp:

From Monday 14th May to Thursday 17th May 2012 : **280 € per person**

JUDOGI

IJF Rules

Blue & White Judogi is obligatory. Judogi control according to Sokuteki rule.

All Judoka must compete in IJF Approved Judogi. The detailed information about the Judogi is available on the EJU website.

Athletes will therefore have to bring with them their judogi, cleaned and without old bib.

REFEREE

Meeting

Each delegation should bring an IJF / Continental licensed referee

DRAW

The draw will be held on Friday 11th May 2012 at 20.00 at the Maison du Judo

EJU / IJF Dress Code: jacket suit with tie.

Seeding of the top 4 competitors in each weight category according to the EJU Junior RL. In case there are 2 athletes from the same country in the top 4, the athletes will be separated by nation.

COMPETITION SYSTEM AND COACHES

Double repechage competition system.

Competition systems with low number of participants:

- 2 entries: better of 2 fights, if 1-1 the third match will decide
- 3,4,5 entries: round robin competition system
- 6 and more entries: repechage competition system.

All coaches must fully adhere to the Code of Conduct for judo Coaches. Forbidden is coaching throughout the contest except for between Matte and Hajime (the coach is only allowed to speak to his athlete between Matte and hajime)

Dress Code:

Draw; jacket suit and tie

Elimination rounds: national track suit with trousers reaching down to shoes, or jacket suit with tie.

For the final block program (TY time): jacket suit with tie

WEIGH IN

Athletes must present accreditation card and passport or national identity card with photo

BACK NUMBERS


Numerical Inscriptions must be sent in about 2 months before. The participating federation should advise how many athletes will be participating.

Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his Judogi the official 2011 EJU / IJF back number.

The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from www.mybacknumber.com. Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks. Athletes without the appropriate back number will be out of the competition, No reserve Judo Gi will be available.

The SPONSOR part (if needed) will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number. In case the participating federation sends fewer athletes than registered in the numerical entry, the federation will be charged the cost of the back number of all cancelled athletes.
