

Participation	In order for an athlete to obtain points for the EJU Ranking List, his / her weight category should have participants from at least 2 different countries. If this is not the case, the competition can still be held, according to the organiser's decision. If, by the nominal deadline, there are less than 2 countries inscribed in any weight
	category, the organizer is obliged to inform immediately the NF concerned. According to EJU rules: Jumas inscription is obligatory. Participants must be registered in Jumas, otherwise they will face a late entry fee of € 30 per participant. The deadline is Monday of the week of the Tournament 30 th April 2012. Jumas membership ordered on site will cost € 30 per card. Jumas system for clubs will be launched in February; we will post the link on the EJU Website.

Competition System	Competition will be carried out according to the EJU / IJF official rules using the double repechage system. Competitor systems with less than 5 competitors will be played in Round Robin (Further information on the EJU Handbook on the EJU Website) Duration: 4 min. Golden Score: 2 min. The white and blue judogi are obligatory in this competition. Preliminaries: 3 mats (7m x 7m) Semifinals: 2 mat (7m x 7m) Finals – 1 mat (7m x 7m). The top 4 competitors in each weight category according to the EJU Junior RL will be seeded. In case there are 2 athletes from the same country in the top 4, the athletes will be separated by nation.

Remarks	For teams from Europe: Please make sure that your team arrives prior to 17:00 h , Friday, May 04, 2012 as no additional or any change of entries will be accepted after 18:00 h.
Transfer	Federations that reserve rooms in the official hotels of competition can make use of all transportation. They will be picked up at the Kaunas or Vilnius airport or train station and after competition transferred back to the airport or train station. Federations not staying in official hotels can't use transportation.
Judogi Advertisement	Please observe the rules of the EJU as far as advertisement on the Judogi is concerned
Judogi Backnumbers	Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his Judogi the official 2011 EJU / IJF back number. The 2011 Back Number version is obligatory. The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from www.mybacknumber.com. Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks. Athletes without the appropriate back number will be out of the competition, no reserve Judogis will be available The SPONSOR part (if needed) will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number. In case the participating federation sends fewer athletes than registered in the numerical entry, the federation will be charged the cost of the back number of all cancelled athletes. Please note, that blue and white judogis will be obligatory. Judogi control according to Sokuteiki rule. Judogi must be IJF approved.
