## Reservation deadline

Reservations are made on a first come first serve basis. When hotels are full you will be offered alternative accommodation. After reservation deadline **Monday 17<sup>th</sup> of October 2011**, we will not be able to guarantee rooms.

## Transportation

The Organizing Committee will provide free transportation as follows:

- transfer from the airport (Amsterdam) or train station (Amsterdam Central) to the check-in and hotel: on Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> November and Friday 18<sup>th</sup> November
- bus service hotel: draw on Friday 18<sup>th</sup> November
- bus service hotel: weigh-in and competition venue on competition days
- transfer from the hotel to the airport (Amsterdam) or train station (Amsterdam Central): on Monday 21<sup>th</sup> November





## Visa

For nations who needs visa to enter The Netherlands, please send us as soon as possible (deadline 31<sup>th</sup> October) a list of participants. Please follow these guidelines for your application:

- visa application should provide full names, sex, passport number, date of birth, issuing date and expiry date of passport, function
- it is possible to send invitation letters by express mail. The expenses will be charged to the account of the federation and must be paid prior or at the check-in

## Judogi

All competitors must have and use their own white and blue judogi according to the IJF rules. All competitors are obliged to have official IJF back numbers with name and country code on their judogi. The local organizing committee will provide tournament back emblems at the check-in. Judoka's are obliged to wear the tournament back emblems and are responsible for attaching the emblems securely to the judogi. Please ensure that your judogi is dry and clean.

## Accreditation

All accreditation cards will be given at the check-in. This accreditation card should be carried at all times. Free accreditations will be given as follows:

### ONLINE REGISTRATION

Without IJF registration in time no participation is possible. No exceptions will be made!!

## Competition Regulations

The competition regulations have been set up to avoid misunderstanding at check-in and registration or during competition and to avoid possible exclusion of competition. Please read the following lines carefully. By registering for competition your federation declares to follow the regulations and to make sure delegations are aware of the regulations.

- 1) The times for check in and registration for accreditation are specified in the programme. Competing federations must arrive and check-in within the time limits of the check-in and registration for accreditation.
- 2) Please consider visa applications **on time** and let the organisation know in advance if documents for facilitating visa applications are needed.

The competitions will be held in accordance with the Sport and Organization Rules and the Refereeing Rules of the International Judo Federation (IJF)

### 1 - WEIGHT CATEGORIES

#### MEN

Extra light weight	up to and including 60 Kg	(-60 Kg)
Half light weight	over 60 Kg up to and including 66 Kg	(-66 Kg)
Light weight	over 66 Kg up to and including 73 Kg	(-73 Kg)
Half middle weight	over 73 Kg up to and including 81 Kg	(-81 Kg)
Middle weight	over 81 Kg up to and including 90 Kg	(-90 Kg)
Half heavy weight	over 90 Kg up to and including 100 Kg	(-100 Kg)
Heavy weight	over 100 Kg	(+ 100 Kg)

#### WOMEN

### 2 - ENTRIES

The number of entries permitted is limited:

2.1 Each National Federation may enter TWO (2) competitors in each of the weight categories, i.e. a total of 28 (14 weight categories each for men and women).

2.2 Three participants from three different countries must compete in a category in order that the championship for that category to be held.





- 2.3 Competitors may only be entered in the weight category to which they belong.
- 2.4 A participant can only be entered in one weight category.
- 2.5 Only the names of the competitors duly entered following the above procedure will be drawn.

### 3 – NATIONALITY

Competitors must be of the same nationality as the National Federation, which has entered them. Proof of nationality will be required according to the Sport and Organization Rules of the IJF.

### 4 - COMPETITORS' AGE

The minimum age limit for competitors is 15 years, born in the year 1996 and before. For those competitors who have not attained their majority (legal adult age), the National Federations should obtain authority from their parents or legal guardians.

### 5 - WEIGH-IN

- 5.1. The weigh-in will be carried out in accordance with the Sport and Organization Rules of the IJF.
- 5.2. The weigh-in will be conducted on the same day that each respective category is being contested.
- 5.3. The competitors shall weigh-in wearing only gymnastic underclothing or naked, under the supervision of a
- 5.4. weigh-in official of the same gender; the competitors may be requested to remove their underclothing to
- 5.5. ensure they are within the prescribed limits of the weight category in which they are entered.
- 5.6. Only one weight control shall be permitted to each competitor up on the scale during the official weigh-in period.
- 5.7. No tolerance shall be allowed either above or below the weight category.
- 5.8. 5.1 The weigh-in will be under the control of the Sports and Refereeing Commissions.
- 5.9. 5.2 Each competitor will bring to the weigh-in his or her IJF accreditation card

### 6 - JUDOGI CONTROL

- 6.1 Approved judogi:  
Competitors should wear an IJF approved judogi supplied by one of the following manufacturers:  
Greenhill, SFJAM NORIS, MIZUNO, Double D Adidas, HAYAKAWA, Fighting FilmS, Budo Sport AG, ESSIMO, MATSURI B.V.
- 6.2 Judogi Control:  
Judogi must have Tag with its Official Label with an optical code provided by IJF which cannot be falsified. One IJF Official Stick on Jacket, one on Trousers and one on Belt.





- 6.3 Backnumber  
Each competitor is obliged to have sewn on the back of his judogi a backnumber bearing his surname and his National Olympic Committee abbreviation. The backnumber can be ordered from [www.mybacknumber.com](http://www.mybacknumber.com). The delivery can take up to 4 weeks.
- 6.4 Advertising  
Competitors should carry on the back of their jacket the IJF dedicated sponsor of the event. Advertising on the judogi must be in compliance with the IJF rules.
- 6.5 National Emblem  
Athletes can have their national emblem on the left front part of the jacket within a space of 100cm<sup>2</sup>.
- N.B It is the responsibility of the judoka to comply with the IJF regulation rules.

## 7. DRAW

- 7.1 The draw will be conducted in accordance with the Sport and Organization Rules of the IJF. It will be held on Friday, November 18th, 2011 at 14h00, under the control and auspices of the IJF Sports Commission.
- 7.2 Each National Federation must send a delegate to attend the draw; a maximum of two delegates per National Federation will be authorized and minimum one should attend the draw. Delegates attending the draw should comply with the IJF Dress Code rule. After the completion of the draw, two sets of the draw lists will be provided to each delegation.
- 7.3 The top eight (8) among the entered competitors in each weight category will be seeded according to the World Ranking List.

## 8 - CONTROL OF THE RIGHT TO COMPETE

The control (based on the Sport and Organization Rules of the IJF) will include:

### **NATIONALITY OF COMPETITORS**

Proof of identity, will be established by production of a passport or an official document or its copy from the country for which the competitor has been entered, and the IJF accreditation card will be issued to each competitor. If a competitor has more than one nationality, such competitor can only represent one country and thereafter may not represent any other country, until after a period of three (3) years has elapsed.

If the two concerned federations desire, they can ask the IJF to reduce or even to suppress this delay in conformity with the Sport and Organization Rules of the IJF and the Olympic Chart, point 42. **Only maximum 2 representatives per National Federation must be personally present and submit for all competitors their identity documents (passport or official identity card).**





## 10 - INSURANCE

- 10.1 Each National Federation is responsible for his/her competitor (s), [the control of non pregnancy as well as gender control, is placed under the responsibility of the National Federation], and must assume all responsibility for accident and health insurance as well as the civil liabilities for their competitors and officials. The IJF nor the organiser has no liability for any claims of illness, injury or death.
- 10.2 All damages to at least, but not limited by, property of hotels, transportation and/or venues resulting from the stay of a national delegation shall be charged to federation and paid in full. The national federation, by registering to this event, declares to accept full responsibility and liability for any and all damages.

## 11 – DURATION OF CONTESTS

MEN & WOMEN: Five (5) minutes (real time). The “Golden score” shall be three (3) minutes.

## 12 – SYSTEM OF COMPETITION

The competition system is the elimination system without repechage with two (2) bronze medals for defeated semi finalists.

## 13 - PARTICULAR RULES FOR WOMEN

Female contestants shall wear under the jacket either, a plain white or off-white tee shirt, with short sleeves, rather strong, long enough to be worn inside the trousers, or a plain white or off-white leotard with short sleeves. All other regulations must be adhered to.

## 14 - CODE OF CONDUCT FOR COACHES

The code of conduct for coaches will be strictly observed. See the Annex of Sport and Organization Rules of the IJF.

## 15 - ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

Grand Prix Amsterdam is under the jurisdiction of IJF so we will have two (2) tests per weight category, according SOR (Annex 7 point 6) and IJF Anti-doping Rules (Art. 5.7.1). Gold Medalist and another medallist by draw will be tested.
