PARTICIPATION	3. Competitors will only represent the Country recognised by their passport.				
	In case a Federation or a club registers an athlete with a different Nationality, a				
	confirmation letter from the Federation of the same Athlete's Nationality should be				
	presented during the accreditation.				
	4. In order for an athlete to obtain points for the EJU Ranking List, his / her weight category				
	should have participants from at least 2 different countries. If this is not the case, the competition can still be held, according to the organiser's decision.				
	5. If, by the nominal deadline, there is only one country inscribed in any weight category, the organizer is obliged to inform immediately the NF concerned.				
	6. According to EJU rules: Jumas inscription is obligatory. Participants must be registered in Jumas, otherwise they will face a late entry fee of € 30 per participant. The deadline is <b>Monday 16</b> <sup>th</sup> <b>July 2012</b> of the week of the Tournament. Participants without a valid EJU Jumas membership have to pay a € 30 penalty per participant. #### **J**UDOGI


Blue & White Judogi is obligatory. Judogi control according to Sokuteki rule.

**All Judoka must compete in IJF Approved Judogi**. The detailed information about the Judogi is available on the EJU website.

#### **BACK NUMBERS**

- 1. Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his Judogi the official 2011 EJU / IJF back number.
- 2. The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from <a href="https://www.mybacknumber.com">www.mybacknumber.com</a>. Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks. Athletes without the appropriate back number will be out of the competition, No reserve Judo Gi will be available.
- 3. The SPONSOR part (if needed) will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number. In case the participating federation sends fewer athletes than registered in the numerical entry, the federation will be charged the cost of the back number of all cancelled athletes.
