

<p><b>PARTICIPATION</b></p>	<p>1. Age Category: age 15 - 19 (<b>born 1993 – 1997</b>)</p> <p>2. <b>All EJU / IJF affiliated countries</b></p> <p>3. Competitors will only represent the Country recognised by their passport.</p> <p><u>In case a Federation or a club registers an athlete with a different Nationality, a confirmation letter from the Federation of the same Athlete's Nationality should be presented during the accreditation.</u></p> <p>4. In order for an athlete to obtain points for the EJU Ranking List, his / her weight category should have participants from at least 2 different countries. If this is not the case, the competition can still be held, according to the organiser's decision.</p> <p>5. If, by the nominal deadline, there is only one country inscribed in any weight category, the organizer is obliged to inform immediately the NF concerned.</p> <p>6. According to EJU rules: Jumas inscription is obligatory. Participants must be registered in Jumas, otherwise they will face a late entry fee of € 30 per participant. The deadline is <b>Monday 16<sup>th</sup> July 2012</b> of the week of the Tournament. Participants without a valid EJU Jumas membership have to pay a € 30 penalty per participant. <p><b>COMPETITION SYSTEM</b></p>	<p>1. Double repechage competition system.</p> <p>2. Competition systems with low number of participants:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ 2 entries: better of 2 fights, if 1-1 the third match will decide</li> <li>▪ 3,4,5 entries: one pool competition system (round robin).</li> <li>▪ 6 and more entries: repechage competition system</li> </ul> <p>3. Updated round robin rules 2012 can be found in the EJU General Handbook on the EJU Website, Downloads section.</p>
<p><b>DRAW</b></p>	<p>1. Draw for all weight categories will be held on <b>Friday 20<sup>th</sup> July 2012</b> at <b>21:00</b> in Hotel Wroclaw.</p> <p>2. Each delegation must be represented at the draw. Competition sheets will be distributed right after the draw.</p> <p>3. EJU / IJF Dress Code: jacket suit with tie.</p> <p>4. Seeding of the top 4 competitors in each weight category according to the EJU Junior RL. In case there are 2 athletes from the same country in the top 4, the athletes will be separated by nation.</p>
<p><b>WEIGH-IN</b></p>	<p>Athletes must present their EJU accreditation and passport or identity card with photo at the official weigh-in.</p> <p>For time and place of the official weigh-in see the Program.</p>
<p><b>REFEREEING</b></p>	<p>The Refereeing will be according to the EJU/IJF refereeing rules.</p>
<p><b>REFEREE</b></p>	<p>Each delegation should bring an IJF/ Continental licensed referee.</p> <p>A referee meeting will be held on <b>Saturday 21<sup>th</sup> July 2012 at 9:00h at the Sport Hall Orbita</b></p>
<p><b>COACHING</b></p>	<p>1. All coaches must fully adhere to the Code of Conduct for Judo Coaches.</p> <p>2. Forbidden is coaching throughout the contest except for between Matte and Hajime (the coach is only allowed to speak to his athlete between Matte and Hajime).</p> <p><b>Dress Code:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Draw: jacket suit and tie</li> <li>-Elimination rounds: national track suit with trousers reaching down to shoes, or jacket suit with tie</li> <li>-For the final block program (TV time): jacket suit with tie.</li> </ul>



<p><b>JUDOGI</b></p>	<p><b>Blue &amp; White Judogi is obligatory.</b> Judogi control according to Sokuteki rule.  <b>All Judoka must compete in IJF Approved Judogi.</b> The detailed information about the Judogi is available on the EJU website.</p>
<p><b>BACK NUMBERS</b></p>	<p>1. Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his Judogi the official 2011 EJU / IJF back number.</p> <p>2. The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from <a href="http://www.mybacknumber.com">www.mybacknumber.com</a>. Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks. Athletes without the appropriate back number will be out of the competition, No reserve Judo Gi will be available.</p> <p>3. The SPONSOR part (if needed) will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number.
