

Participation	<p>This competition is open for all EJU / IJF Member Federations: <u>Maximum 4 competitors</u> per weight category for every federation. The competitors must be of the same nationality as the national federation, which enters them.</p>
Accreditation. Control of entries	<p><u>At least one team official and maximum two must attend the accreditation on Friday 01.02. 2013 from 10:00 to 18:00</u> in order to confirm the delegation. Without this confirmation in time a nation will not be put into draw and not be allowed to start. Each Head of Delegation must be present, during the control of participants, with proof of their nationality (passport or national ID card with photography or photocopy of a document).</p>
Age	<p>Minimum 15 years of age (born in 1998 or before)</p>
Competition Mode	<p>The competition will be carried out according to the rules and sporting codes of the IJF and EJU. The application of new testing rules of IJF be destined for European Open. Competition system: An elimination (KO) system with the quarterfinal (last 8) repechage.</p>
Duration of contests	<p>5 minutes and the Golden Score with no time limit</p>
Weigh-in	<p>Attention: According to preliminary IJF information the weigh in all WRL events is intended the evening before the competition day from January 2013.</p> <p>Athletes must present their EJU accreditation and passport or national ID card with photography at the official weigh-in. For time and place of the official weigh-in see the Program. The scales for check of the weight will be accessible from 9:00 until 18:30 in</p>
Refereeing	<p>Each federation may enter 1 referee</p> <p>The organizing federation a maximum of 4 referees.</p> <p>Referees must be holding the IJF license A or B and with a valid classification A or B.</p> <p>A referee meeting will be held on Friday 01.02.2013 at 19:00hrs at the Vitosha Park Hotel</p> <p>The attendance to the Referee meeting is strictly compulsory. The referees should be dressed formally for this meeting.</p>
Draw	<p>Seeding of the top 8 among the entered competitors according to the IJF World Ranking List. The rest s of the draw – separation by nations.</p> <p>The draw will take place on Friday 01.2013 at 20:00hrs in Vitosha Park Hotel. Each delegation must be represented at the draw, maximum two officials.</p> <p><u>Dress code:</u> jacket suit with tie</p>
Jumas	<p>According to EJU rules: Jumas inscription is obligatory. Participants must be</p>



	<p>registered in Jumas, otherwise they will face a late entry fee of € 30 per participant. The deadline is Monday 28.01.2013 (<i>of the week of the Tournament</i>). Participants without a valid EJU Jumas membership have to pay a € 30 penalty per participant. Jumas membership must then be ordered through the federation. Entry Fee	<p>An entry fee of 10 € per athlete must be paid to the EJU during accreditation.</p>
Coaching	<p>All coaches must fully adhere to the Code of Conduct for Judo Coaches. Forbidden is coaching throughout the contest, the coach is only allowed to speak to his athlete between Matte and Hajime</p> <p>Dress Code:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Draw: jacket suit and tie- Elimination rounds: national track suit with trousers reaching down to shoes or jacket suit and tie- For the final block program: jacket suit with tie.
Judogi	<p>The competitions will be held in white and blue judogi. Judogi control according to IJF Sokuteiki Rule. Only Judogi from IJF suppliers will be allowed.</p> <p>Judogi markings must be in accordance with the EJU regulations.</p> <p>Detailed information is available from http://www.eju.net/statutes</p>
