Closest Airport and Train Station Transport	<p>Airport: <b>Vienna International Airport</b>  Railway stations: <b>Wien Hauptbahnhof</b> or <b>Wien Meidling</b> or <b>Graz Hauptbahnhof</b></p> <p>The organizer will provide transfers between airport or railway station and official hotel and between the official hotel and competition venue. Transportation will be offered only to those participants who are accommodated in the official hotel.</p> <p>Transfers between Airport/Railwaystation and the official hotel are <b>free of charge</b> on <b>Friday 15<sup>th</sup></b>, <b>Monday 18<sup>th</sup></b> and <b>Thursday 21<sup>st</sup></b> of February. For transfers on other days an extra fare of € 20,-- per person and per direction is charged. Participating NF are responsible for their own travel to Austria.</p>
Participation	<p>This <b>European Open</b> is open for all EJU / IJF Member Federations: <u>Maximum 4 competitors</u> per weight category for every federation. The competitors must be of the same nationality as the national federation, which enters them.</p>
Accreditation Control of entries	<p>At least one team official and maximum two must attend the accreditation on Friday February 15<sup>th</sup> from 10:00-18:00 in order to confirm the delegation. Without this confirmation in time, a nation will not be put into draw and not be allowed to start. Each Head of Delegation must be present, during the control of participants, with proof of their nationality (passport or national ID card with photography or photocopy of a document).</p>
Age	<p>Minimum 15 years of age (born in 1998 or before)</p>
Competition Mode	<p>The competition will be carried out according to the rules and sporting codes of the IJF and EJU. The new IJF testing rules approved for a period until the WC Rio de Janeiro 2013 will be applied for the European Open.</p> <p>Competition system: Elimination (KO) system with the quarterfinal (last 8) repechage.</p>
Duration of contests	<p><b>5 Minutes</b> - Golden Score without time limit.</p>
Weigh-in	<p>Athletes must present their <b>EJU accreditation</b> and <b>Passport</b> or national ID card with photography at the official weigh-in.</p> <p>For time and place of the official weigh-in see the Program.</p> <p>The scales for check of the weight will be provided from 08:00 until 19:00 in TV Hotel on days of the official weigh-in.</p>
Refereeing	<p>Each federation may enter <b>1 referee</b> with at least continental licence and valid classification A or B. The organizing federation may enter a maximum of <b>4 referees</b>.</p> <p>Referees must be holding the IJF license A or B and with a valid classification A or B.</p> <p>The referee meeting will be held on <b>Friday 15<sup>th</sup> of February at 19:00 hrs</b> at <b>TV Hotel</b>. The attendance to the Referee meeting is strictly compulsory. The referees should be dressed formally for this meeting.</p>
Draw	<p>Seeding of the <b>Top 8</b> among the entered competitors according to <b>the IJF World Ranking List</b>. The rest of the draw – separation by nations.</p> <p>The draw will take place on <b>Friday 15<sup>th</sup> of February at 20:00 hrs</b> at <b>TV Hotel</b>.</p> <p>Each delegation must be represented at the draw, maximum two officials.</p> <p><u>Dress code:</u> jacket suit with tie</p>

Jumas	<p>All entries must be registered in JUMAS (EJU online registration system). Jumas website : <a href="https://jumas12.net/user/login">https://jumas12.net/user/login</a> Deadline for registration is <b>Monday, 11<sup>th</sup> of February 2013.</b></p> <p>Delegates not registered in Jumas will be charged <b>30 €</b> late entry fee. Jumas membership ordered on site will cost <b>€ 30</b> per membership.</p>
Entry Fee	An entry fee of 10 € per athlete must be paid to the EJU during accreditation.
Coaching	<p>All coaches must fully adhere to the Code of Conduct for Judo Coaches. Dress Code: Draw: jacket suit and tie Elimination rounds: national track suit with trousers reaching down to shoes or jacket suit and tie. Final block program (TV time): jacket suit and tie.</p>
Judogi	<p>The white and blue judogi are obligatory. Judogi control is performed according to the Sokuteiki Rule. All Judoka must compete in <b>IJF Approved Judogi</b>. See Official Suppliers on the EJU website. Judogi markings must be in accordance with the EJU regulations. Detailed information is available on <a href="http://www.eju.net/statutes">http://www.eju.net/statutes</a></p> <p><b>If the Judogi of the athlete does not comply with all the specifications of the EJU and the IJF, including the Back Number, the athlete will be disqualified from the tournament.</b></p>
Back Numbers	<p>Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his Judogi the <b>official 2011 EJU / IJF back number</b>.</p> <p>It can be ordered from <a href="http://www.mybacknumber.com">www.mybacknumber.com</a> or <a href="http://www.ijfbacknumber.com">www.ijfbacknumber.com</a> Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks.</p> <p>The SPONSOR part (if needed) will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">New back identification of athletes 01.01.2011</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  <p>The diagram illustrates the placement and specifications of back numbers on a judogi. Responsibility of the Federations	<p><i>The competitors will compete under the full responsibility of their federations.</i></p> <p><b>Insurance:</b> Each national federation is responsible for insuring its competitors against 'injury and third part risk (public liability)' during the period of the championships. The European Judo Union and Austrian Judo Federation decline all responsibility.</p>
