4. Participation

5. EJU Participation Fee

30 € per participating athlete of EJU Member Federations

100 € per participating athlete of Non-EJU Member Federations

6. Age

15 years old and over (Born in 2004 and before)

7. Responsibility of the Federations

The athletes will train under the full responsibility of their National Federations. Each National Federation is responsible for insuring its judoka against 'injury and third part risk (public liability)' during the period of the camp. The European Judo Union and Belarusian Judo Federation decline all responsibility.

8. Facilities

Available for athletes: 1200 m² tatami, gym, saunas, spaces for leisure activities and other services.

9. Transport

Airport: Minsk-2 National Airport (MSQ)

Distance from the Airport to the official hotel: 35 km

Railway station: Minsk Pasažyrski

The organizer will provide transfer between Minsk-2 National Airport / Minsk Pasažyrski railway station and the official hotel. Transportation will be offered to the participants accommodated at the official hotel only. Participating National Federations are responsible for their own travel to Minsk/Belarus.

Early arrivals or late departures will be charged in accordance with the pricelist of the Republican Olympic Training Center Stayki.

Included:

Accommodation with full board (**lunch & dinner + breakfast the next day**), access to sports facilities, sauna, promotional and informational materials, medical aid during trainings, transportation from Minsk (airport/railway station) to the Republican Olympic Training Center Stayki and back.

To be accredited, all participants must stay at the official hotel.

In case any damage to hotel property or competition venue caused by members of delegations, a proper national federation will be charged by the Republican Olympic Training Center Stayki.

Reservations will be processed strictly according to the date of your booking. In case the desired category is fully booked, you will be informed and requested to make a new reservation.

In case that the Official Hotels are fully booked the organizers reserve the right to arrange accommodation in another hotel of the same standard at the prices mentioned above.

All participants of the training camp must stay at the official hotels during its duration. Accommodation must be booked directly through the Republican Olympic Training Center Stayki. Other persons shall not be accepted for trainings.

14. Visa

For nations who need VISA to enter Belarus, please send the "Visa Application Form" fully filled along with passports copies of all the members of the delegation not later than **Wednesday, 1 May 2019**.

Note: PDF FORMATS or HAND WRITING SHALL BE REJECTED.

Please pay attention to the following information:

1. The Republic of Belarus allows VISA-FREE ENTRY for up to 30 days. According to the requirements of such kind of entry all members of delegations (foreign citizens of 74 countries) must arrive to or depart from the Republic of Belarus through Minsk-2 National Airport only, having on hand the following:

- valid passport;
- financial means: at least 25 Euros (or equal amount in USD or BYN) for every day of stay;
- medical insurance covering at least 10,000 Euros valid for the entire territory of Belarus (the period of insurance should cover the whole period of stay in the Republic of Belarus). Medical insurance can be obtained on arrival at the airport.
